The meeting shall also include the parties involved in cases W1-11-1917.

To facilitate discussions at the meeting, all parties are directed to bring to the meeting any deeds, aerial photographs, wells logs and other documents that are readily available to the party and relevant to the ownership of the land and past and present irrigation on the land.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** staying consideration of the claim for domestic use and any portion of the claim for irrigation use designated as 112-17-BAD-018-IR001 for which Well 4 as referenced in ADWR's map and report filed November 16, 2018.
