Assessor has identified as owned by C-Spear LLC, an Arizona limited liability company. This contested case is one of the many cases in the General Stream Adjudication for the San Pedro River watershed. Other cases in which claims have been made to water in the San Pedro River watershed have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or awaiting initiation.

The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the rights of those persons who filed statement of claimants for rights to use water from the San Pedro watershed. The General Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria and Upper Santa Cruz watershed. Persons who fail to timely file statements of claimant will forfeit any rights to the use of water in this river system and source.

In this case, the Conservator of the Estate of Hope I. Jones filed Statements of Claimant for the legal rights to use water on land that is more specifically shown on the map attached as Attachment A. The land involved in this case is labelled as "(1)". The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated those claims and prepared a report known as Watershed File Report 113-12-CAA-001 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Hope Iselin Jones was identified as the owner of the property described in the WFR. The WFR identified one potential water right for domestic use, two small reservoirs, and two potential water rights for irrigation use on the land described in the WFR. Three wells are listed as the sources of the water. In addition, ADWR also included an additional well as a "cataloged well." Arizona Department of Water Resources has determined that two wells listed in the WFR and a cataloged well are located within the subflow zone of the San Pedro River. A copy of the WFR and the report concerned the cataloged well are attached as Attachment B.

After the Arizona Department of Water Resources issued the WFR, objections by the original claimant as well as other water user were filed to the findings in the WFR. The purpose of this case to consider the claims made for water rights that were investigated in the WFR and resolve the objections to the WFR.

Claimant & Landowner

The WFR identified ten Statements of Claimant (SOCs) relevant to the potential water right: 39-5822 and 39-5823. In 2018, a form of assignment was filed with Arizona Department of Water Resources to assign the SOCs to C-Spear LLC. The records of the Cochise County Assessor identified C-Spear LLC as the owner of tax parcels 209-01-003C, 209-03-002, and 209-01-005 shown on Attachment C.

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Hope Ieslin Jones* and it will determine water rights asserted in the Statements of Claimant and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report 113-12-CAA-001 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be found under the case name and number on the following website: http://www.superiorcourt.maricopa.gov/SuperiorCourt/GeneralStreamAdjudication/whatsNew.asp
- 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, C-Spear LLC, and all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file reports who are included on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.

- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County
 Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the
 Court-approved mailing list. No pleadings, correspondence, or
 documents will be accepted by the Special Master that are not also filed
 with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court and mailed to each
 person listed on the Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.



5. Status Conference.

- A. An initial status conference shall be held to determine whether objections to the WFR can be settled and the amount of time that the parties will require to discuss the resolution of the objections. If the objections cannot be settled between the Claimant and the Objectors, then a scheduling conference will be held at a later date to:
 - a. identify issues;
 - set deadlines to file disclosure statements, conduct discovery,
 and submit prehearing motions; and,

c. fix a date for a trial on the claimed water rights. 


