This contested case is one of the many cases in the General Stream Adjudication for the San Pedro River watershed. Other cases in which claims have been made to water in the San Pedro River watershed have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or awaiting initiation. The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the water rights of those persons who filed statements of claimant to use water from the San Pedro watershed. The

1 General Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila,
2 Lower Gila, Agua Fria, and Upper Santa Cruz watersheds.

3 This contested case shall determine the claims for water rights listed in and resolve the
4 objections to Watershed File Report 113-14-AA-001 (“WFR”) published in the Final San Pedro
5 River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The WFR identified potential water
6 rights for domestic, irrigation, and small reservoir uses for the land described in the WFR located
7 in Township 13S Range 20E, Township 14S Range 20E, and Township 17S Range 20E. The
8 identified sources of water for the claimed uses are eleven wells. The Arizona Department of
9 Water Resources has determined that all of the wells are located within the subflow zone except
10 Well 08 located in Section 8 T14S R20E. A copy of the watershed file report is attached as
11 Attachment A. A copy of the map prepared for the WFR is attached as Attachment B on which
12 the land investigated is labelled with “(1)”.

13 14 15 **Claimants & Landowners**

16
17 The WFR identified 16 Statements of Claimant (SOC) relevant to the potential water
18 rights. The Claimants in this case are Cascabel Land and Cattle Co., the Nature Conservancy,
19 and E. Lamar Smith, who filed or were assigned SOCs claiming rights to water for stock
20 watering, irrigation, and domestic uses. The Arizona Department of Water Resources listed
21 Reesor G. Woodling as the owner of the property described in the WFR. According to the public
22 records of Cochise County Treasurer’s Office, the property including within the boundaries of
23 the WFR now consists of 17 different tax parcels as follows:

1 2. Litigants. The litigants in this contested case, are the Claimants, current
2 landowners who are listed on page 3, all persons who filed objections to Watershed File Report
3 113-14-AA-001, who are listed on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene
4 by order.

5 3. Court-Approved Mailing List.

7 A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include the

1 the objections to the potential water rights can be settled. If the objections cannot be settled, then
2 a subsequent date will be set for a scheduling conference to identify issues, file disclosure
3 statements, conduct discovery, submit prehearing motions, and hold a trial. The Telephonic

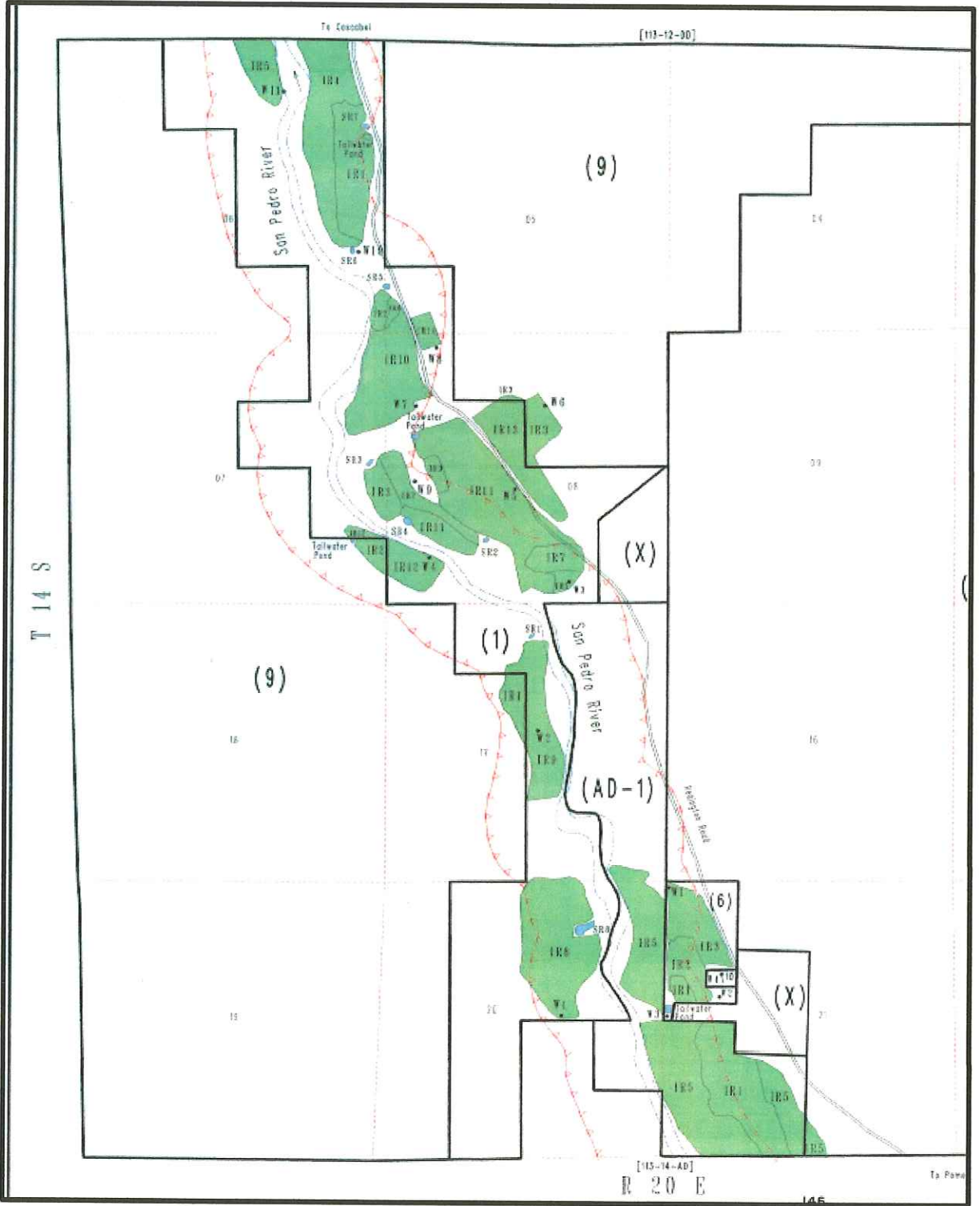

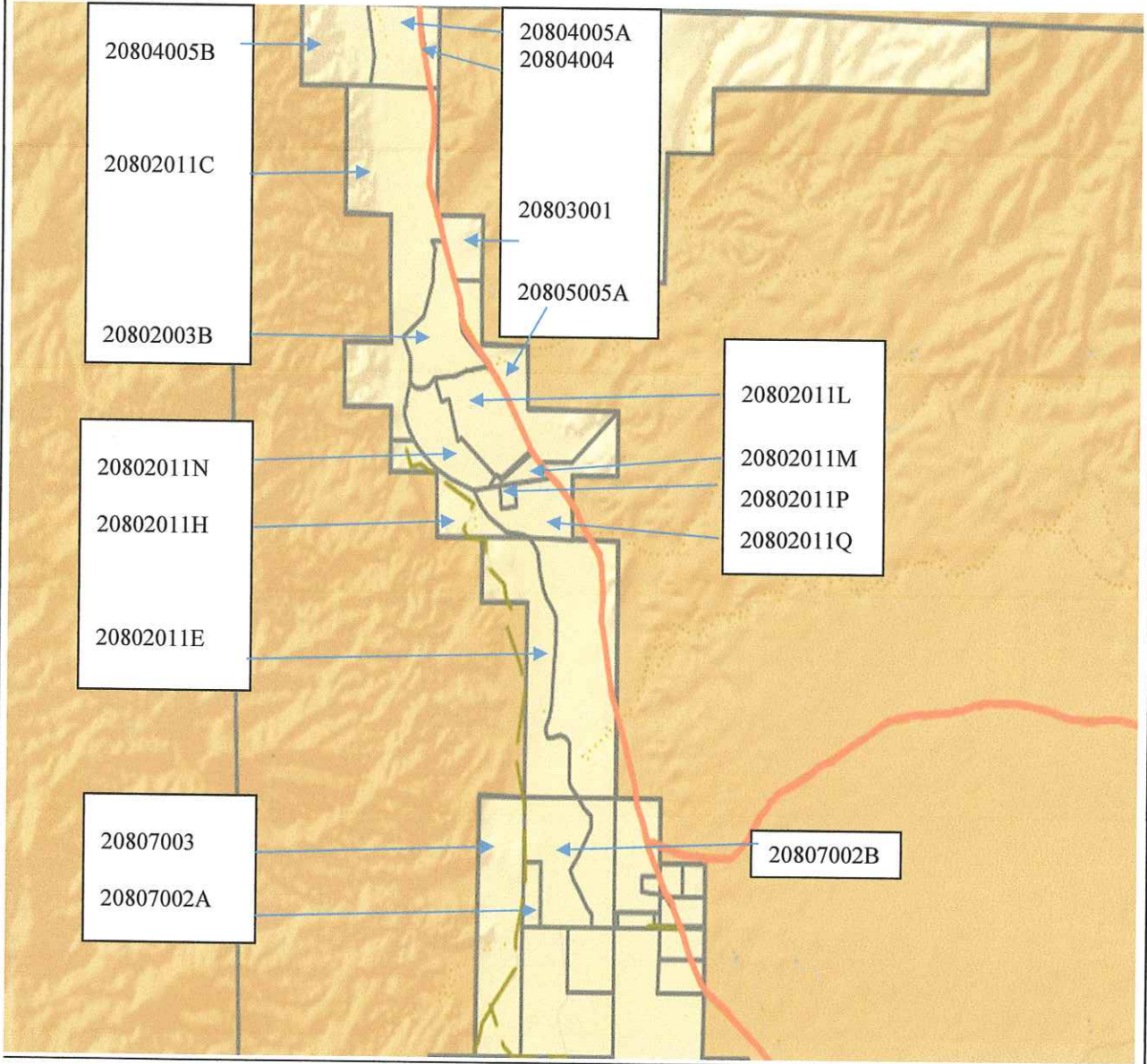
