11:26 a.m. This is the time set for a status conference before Special Water Susan Ward Harris regarding *Pima County's Proposal on Objections* and *Arizona State Land Departments Report Regarding Ownership of Land Identified in WFR No. 113-09-020* 

The following attorneys and parties appear in-person: Michael Foy and Mark McGinnis on behalf of Salt River Project.

The following attorneys and parties appear telephonically: Michael McNulty and Michael LeBlanc on behalf of Pima County (County); Joe Sparks on behalf of San Carlos Apache Tribe and Tonto Apace Tribe; Kimberly Parks on behalf of AZ Department of Water Resources (ADWR); Carrie Brennan on behalf of AZ State Land Department; and Jay Tomkus on behalf of the Pascua Yaqui Tribe and Yavapai-Apache Nation.

Court reporter, Celeste Paxton Jones, is present and a record of these proceedings is made digitally.

The Court notes that this case involves five watershed file reports (WFRs): 111-19-001, 113-09-020, 113-11-003, 113-12-001, and 113-12-BD-002. It appears that claims for *de minimis* uses for stockponds are listed in three WFRs: WFRs 111-19-001, 113-11-003, and 113-12-001.

The County requests the dismissal of Statements of Claimant (SOC) 39-15960 and 39-78564 because they are duplicative of 39-5395 and 39-1726, respectively.

IT IS ORDERED dismissing SOC 39-15960 and 39-78564.

The Court also notes that WFR 113-12-001 includes wells used for domestic use that the County claims are outside the subflow zone and three stockpond uses. The County is asserting a claim to PWR113-12-001-SW002 but not to PWR113-12-001-SW001 and PWR113-12-001-SW003 because it does not own the land. Mr. LeBlanc believes that the Arizona State Land Department (ASLD) owns the land described as the places of use for PWR113-12-001-SW001 and PWR113-12-001-SW003.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** directing ASLD to prepare a report regarding land ownership in WFR 113-12-001 and specifically the ownership of the land listed as the places of use for PWRs 113-12-001-SW001 and 113-12-001-SW003.

Discussion is held concerning the ASLD's report concerning the ownership of land identified in WFR 113-09-020.

Further discussion is held concerning the incorrect legal description for the point of diversion in WFR 113-09-020. Based on the legal description of the water use provided in SOC 39-2771, that SOC is thought to be included in the wrong WFR.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** removing WFR 113-09-020 from this case. SOC 39-2771 will be analyzed in the amended WFR 113-12-BD-002.

Discussion is held whether Pima County owns all the land with water rights as claimed or are the subject of PWRs in WFR 113-12-BD-002. The court inquires if the County has filed all of the amended SOCs it intends to file.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** directing Pima County to file a report by April 2, 2018, regarding the status of their amended SOCs.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** directing ADWR to amend WFR 113-12-BD-002 by April 23, 2018. Amended objections are to be submitted by May 21, 2018.

Mr. Foy states that the domestic wells listed in WFRs 111-19-001, 113-11-003, and 113-12-001 that constitute *de minimis* claims should remain within the adjudication because the cones of depression of the wells may impact the subflow zone.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that by April 23, 2018, Pima County shall submit documentation to support its position that the wells for which it asserts water rights and listed in WFRs 111-19-001, 113-11-003, and 113-12-001 are located outside the subflow zone.

The Arizona State Land Department shall file a report concerning the ownership of the land listed as the places of use for PWRs 113-12-001-SW001 and 113-12-001-SW003 by April 23, 2018.
