MINUTE ENTRY

The Court has reviewed the materials filed in connection with the pending Motion In Limine to Preclude Introduction of Evidence on Issues Other Than Quantity. The Court believes it has repeatedly explained the scope of the evidentiary hearing that will commence August 20, 2007. The hearing will treat only with the question of whether the Gila River system and source water rights granted to the Gila River Indian Community (the "Community") under the proposed settlement are no more extensive than those rights the Community would be able to prove at trial. The Court will only consider evidence relevant to this issue. Because the 109-page Joint Pretrial Statement filed in connection with this Special Proceeding contains issues unrelated to this proceeding,

IT IS ORDERED granting the Motion in Limine in part. Those participating in the August 20, 2007 hearing will only be permitted to present evidence the Court deems relevant to the inquiry set forth above.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED signing this minute entry as an order of the Court.
