DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: The Special Master conducted an *in camera* review of documents produced by the United States in response to a Motion to Compel filed by Freeport Minerals Corporation.

On March 16, 2016, the United States produced 25 separate documents for *in camera* review asserting that the documents are protected by attorney client privilege and/or work product protection. It also submitted a Partial Amended and Supplemental Privilege Log that included certain representations about the documents produced. The United States made the additional representation that none of the 25 documents had been provided to the expert witnesses named by the United States in this case.
