In addition to the information required above, please provide a brief (no more than 1 page) narrative describing your proposal and why your community would be the best host community for the 2020 APA Mississippi-Alabama Fall Conference.

Your proposal must be able to provide:

- Dates should be in October (if possible), with preference given to the second week.
- Three conference days (Half-Day Wednesday, Thursday, and Half-Day Friday).
- The conference venue should have, or be located within close proximity to, adequate and appropriate hotel facilities.
- Activities and points of interest in the community.
- A large lecture hall for the keynote address (100-150 attendees).
- Ideas for interesting, and engaging keynote presenters.
- Room for two-four sessions to run concurrently.
- The potential for several mobile workshops of various planning related interests.
- Adequate space for vendor displays and breaks/refreshments between sessions (it is preferable for these to be close together or even combined)
- A large dining facility for the conference awards luncheon.
- Space for conference registration and check-in.
- Opportunities for local sponsorship.
