#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- High School graduating seniors and eligible transfers (new students at Bellevue University)
- US citizens, legal permanent residents
- Full-time enrollment and pursuing a bachelor's degree
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Financial need required (FAFSA completed and submitted and eligible to receive a Pell Grant)
- Must have been part of P4K for at least two years
- Must be nominated by a member of the P4K organization staff

## **faq's** about the Partnership 4 Kids Scholarship

#### Q: Is this scholarship awarded per term throughout the duration of enrollment?

A: Yes, the scholarship award amounts are added each term based on the total cost of the tuition, fees, books, and on-campus housing and food minus other free aid. If all eligibility requirements continue to be met during the first year of enrollment, this scholarship may be renewed for additional academic years.

### Q: Can this scholarship be applied to housing?

A: Yes, this scholarship can be applied towards tuition, fees, books, on-campus housing and food.

# Q: Are there programmatic requirements that must be met in order to receive the scholarship?

A: Yes, there are certain requirements that must be met throughout the course of the academic year. You must be enrolled full-time, maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA, and take LA 105 and pass with a grade of "C+ or better. You must also participate in all of the required scholarship activities and orientation.

### Q: Can this scholarship be refunded?

A: No, this scholarship is not refundable.

#### Q: Are there requirements from P4K that must be met in order to receive the scholarship?

A: Yes, there are certain requirements that must be met throughout the course of the academic year as set by Partnership 4 Kids.

## Q: Can this scholarship be stacked with other types of aid?
