Land law examiners help answer the question of what land gets transferred to another party. They also help figure out if there are legal restrictions for different activities. They process various kinds of case files with the purpose of conveying lands.



### What you will do:

#### **Review Applications and Claims:**

- Examine applications to adjudicate land ownership.
- Spot legal issues.
- Evaluate and document facts and evidence.
- Apply laws and regulations or government policies to land transfer of land law issues.
- Review files for completeness & make determinations.

#### **Draft and Issue Documents:**


- Compose letters, notices, decisions, and memoranda to customers relative to land transfer actions.
- Approve or reject land applications.
- Publish notices in the Federal Register.

### **Research Land Records:**

Research and interpret plats, indices, surveys, and other land records to determine land ownership, types of ownership, and other land status for case processes and inquiries.

#### **Conduct Legal Reviews:**

- Examine titles, legal land descriptions, and records.
- Solve legal issues regarding land ownership and rights.
- Work closely with federal and state agencies and Alaska Native corporations.
