Keith Dinwiddie and Guadalupe Ramirez Durazo. This contested case is one of the many cases in the General Stream Adjudication for the San Pedro River watershed. Other cases in which claims have been made to water in the San Pedro River watershed have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or awaiting initiation. The purpose of the General Stream Adjudication is to determine the rights of those persons who filed statement of claimants for rights to use appropriable water in the San Pedro watershed. The General Streams Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria and Upper Santa Cruz watersheds.

In this case, Edgar and Lorraine Dinwiddie filed Statements of Claimant 39-5363, 39-5364, 39-5365, 39-5366, and 39-5367 (collectively "SOCs") to claims rights to water for domestic, stock watering and irrigation uses. The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated those claims and prepared Watershed File Report 111-24-CBC-006 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Based on its investigation, ADWR found potential water rights for water for stockponds, and domestic and irrigation uses on the land. A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment A. The land included with the boundaries of the WFR is shown on the map attached as Attachment B and labelled as "(6)".

The Arizona Department of Water Resources identified four wells as the sources of water for the claimed uses. It has determined that wells 01, 02, 03, and 04 are within the subflow zone. After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made by the ADWR in the WFR. The purpose of this case is to consider the claims made for water rights that are the subject of the WFR and resolve the objections to the WFR.

Claimants & Landowners

The public records maintained by ADWR do not include assignments of the SOCs from Edgar F. and Lorraine Dinwiddie to successor landowners. Accordingly, Edgar F. and Lorraine Dinwiddie shall be known as the Claimants. The records of the Cochise County Assessor list Keith Dinwiddie and Guadalupe Ramirez Durazo as the owners of the property described in the WFR. A copy of a map prepared by the Cochise County Assessor showing tax parcel 104-41-001 is attached as Attachment C.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. <u>Contested Case</u>.

- A. This contested case is initiated and shall be known as *In re Edgar and Lorraine Dinwiddie*. It will determine appropriable water rights asserted in Statements of Claimant 39-5363, 39-5364, 39-5365, 39-5366, and 39-5367 and resolve objections filed to WFR 111-24-CBC-006 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991).
- B. Copies of objections can be obtained upon request from the Arizona
 Department of Water Resources.
- C. Copies of objection can also be found on the website maintained by the Maricopa County Superior Court for the General Streams Adjudication on the Active Cases page. The objections for each case are listed under the case number. The objections can also be accessed using the following link: http://www.superiorcourt.maricopa.gov/SuperiorCourt/GeneralStreamAdjudication/whatsNew.asp
- Litigants. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimants, the current landowners, all persons who filed objections to the WFR, who are included on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. Court-Approved Mailing List.

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Clerk will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list.

 Upon request, the Clerk of the Court will provide copies by email. Parties may request emailed copies of minute entries and orders by completing and submitting a CONSENT FOR ELECTRONIC RECEIPT OF WATER CASE DOCUMENTS, which is attached as Attachment E.
- 4. <u>Status Conference</u>. An initial status conference shall be held to determine whether the Claimants have or intend to assign the SOCs to current landowners and whether the current landowners intend to pursue claims for rights to water for use on the land included within the boundaries of the WFR.

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A. If the Claimants or current landowners intend to pursue rights to appropriable water for use on the land, the parties will be expected to advise whether they are interested in pursuing discussions to resolve the objections to the WFR and the amount of time that the parties believe will be necessary to complete those discussions.

B. If the objections cannot be settled, then a subsequent date will be set for a scheduling conference to identify issues, file disclosure statements, conduct discovery, submit prehearing motions, and hold a trial. No party shall conduct any discovery or file any motions prior to the Status Conference.

The Status Conference shall be held on August 18, 2021 at 3:45 p.m. The Status Conference will be conducted using the Court Connect program. 


