The Court stated that at the last status conference Mr. Sparks raised the possibility that the form of statement of claimant is not in compliance with the statute. with Mr. Sparks that the filing is not an argument that a statement of claimant must be revised to comply with the statute but rather a request for additional information.

Mr. Sparks said that the request was a list of basic evidentiary documents that it believes necessary to support the claims.

Argument is presented on the Parties' respective positions on the issue of inclusion of additional information in the amended Statements of Claimants from the St. David Irrigation District for irrigation uses and if this case should be the one to deal with the chain of title issue.

Based upon the argument and information presented,

The Court will treat Mr. Spark's motion as an informal request for discovery from St. David Irrigation District. No deadlines will be attached by the Court for responses to the request.
