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Claimants & Landowners

The Report identified one Statement of Claimant (SOC) relevant to the potential water right: 39-4978. Daniel R. Cloud and Robert Stephens ("Claimants") filed the SOC claiming water for irrigation, stockwatering, and domestic uses. The Report lists David T. and Marilyn Lee and Daniel T. and Virginia Cloud and Robert and Sarah Stephens as the owners of the property described in the Report. On March 19, 1992, Arizona Department of Water Resources issued Certificates of Water Right 85239 and 85240 to Daniel T. and Virginia Cloud and Robert

the General Stream Adjudication for the San Pedro River watershed. Other cases in which claims have been made to water in the San Pedro River watershed have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or awaiting imitiation. The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the rights of those persons who filed statement of claimants for rights to use appropriable water in the San Pedro watershed. The General Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria and Upper Santa Cruz watershed.

In this case, Daniel T. Cloud and Robert V. Stephens (collectively "Claimants") filed a statement of claimant for rights to use appropriable water on land in Section 7 Township 8S Range 21E. The Arizona Department of Water Resources investigated those claims and prepared a report known as a Zone 2 Well Report 115-06-CCA-001 ("Report") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). A copy of the Report is attached as Attachment A.

The Report found water used for domestic and irrigation purposes on the land, which is more specifically shown on the map attached as Attachment B and labelled as "(1)". Three wells are listed as the sources of the water. After the Arizona Department of Water Resources issued the Report, objections were filed to the findings made by the Arizona Department of Water Resources in the Report. The purpose of this case is to consider the claims made for water rights that are the subject of the Report and resolve the objections to the Report.

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and Sarah Stephens for domestic, stockwatering and irrigation water uses on Section 7 Township 8 South, Range 21 East. In 1999, those Certificates of Water Right were assigned to Indian Springs Ranch Partnership. The public records maintained by the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not include an assignment of the SOC from the Claimants to successor landowners and do not include an assignment of the Certificates of Water Rights from Indian Springs Ranch Partnership to successor landowners.

A warranty deed, document 2004-01346, was filed with the Graham County Recorder's Office on March 11, 2004, that named Indian Springs Ranch Partnership as the grantor and Roy G. and Yvonne Haught, Clayton R. and Allison D. Randall, as the grantees of land in Section 7, Township 8S Range 21E. The records of the Graham County Assessor list Roy G. and Yvonne Haught, Richard B. Holcomb and Karen C. Holcomb, as trustees, and Richard B. Holcomb and Karen C. Holcomb, as trustees as the owners of the property described in the Report. A copy of a map prepared by the Graham County Assessor showing tax parcels 111-08-001B, 111-08-001D, and 111-08-001E is attached as Attachment C.

#### **IT IS ORDERED:**

- Contested Case. This contested case shall be known as In re David T. & Marilyn 1. Lee et al. and it will determine appropriable water rights asserted in the Statement of Claimant and objections that were filed to the Report 115-06-CCA-001 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). - Litigants. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimants, the current landowners, all persons who filed objections to the Report, who are included on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

### Court-Approved Mailing List.

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Clerk will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list.

  Upon request, the Clerk of the Court will provide copies by email. Parties may request emailed copies of minute entries and orders by completing and submitting a CONSENT FOR ELECTRONIC RECEIPT OF WATER CASE DOCUMENTS, which is attached as Attachment E.

#### 4. Status Conference.

A. An initial status conference shall be held to determine whether the Claimants, Roy G. and Yvonne Haught, Clayton R. and Allison D. Randall, as trustees, and Richard B. Holcomb and Karen C. Holcomb, as trustees, intend to pursue claim for rights to appropriable water. If so, the parties seeking water rights shall be prepared at the Status Conference to

provide information about efforts undertaken to assign or file Statements of Claimant and assign Certificates of Water Right to current landowners.

B. If the Claimants or current landowners intend to pursue rights to appropriable water for use on the land, the parties will be expected to advise whether they are interested in pursuing discussions to resolve the objections to the Report and the amount of time that the parties believe will be necessary to complete those discussions.

C. If the objections cannot be settled, then a subsequent date will be set for a scheduling conference to identify issues, file disclosure statements, conduct discovery, submit prehearing motions, and hold a trial. No party shall conduct any discovery or file any motions prior to the Status Conference.

The Status Conference shall be held on August 18, 2021 at 3:30 p.m. The Status Conference shall be held using the Court Connect program. Instructions for Court Connect are attached as Attachment F. 
