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ATTACHMENT A

The following standard instructions have been adopted in the Maricopa County Superior Court for Civil hearings proceeding by video/audio. Please be prepared to comply with them during any future hearings in this case.

1. Downloading & Testing Software: Use the link provided to download the GoToMeeting application software. The software can be downloaded via a computer, smartphone, or other smart device. You should ensure that you download the application software on the device you intend to use at the actual hearing. Ensure that device has a microphone and webcam (most laptops, smartphones, and Ipads have a camera and microphone). You can also access the hearing by using a telephone.
2. You are responsible for ensuring that you and your witnesses have downloaded the GoToMeeting software in advance of the hearing. In the event that you have any technical issues with the software or access to a device, you must contact this division in advance.
3. Any person appearing at the hearing must ensure access to a quiet, secure room during the hearing that is free from audio and visual distractions. If a person does not have a reliable internet connection, the person should access the hearing by telephone.
4. Testifying witnesses at any hearing may not be coached by third-parties and must not read from documents not marked and admitted in evidence. If Ariz. R. Evid. 615 is invoked, non-party witnesses must be instructed not to listen into the proceedings via the audience line.
5. If you are not co-located with your client, ensure that you have a mechanism to confer privately if necessary during the hearing.
6. **Avoid using speaker phone.**
7. Mute your microphone when you are not speaking during the hearing.
8. If you need a break, request a recess. Do not simply turn off your camera and leave the hearing.
9. Dress appropriately for a court proceeding.
10. If appearing by video, avoid improper or inappropriate items in the background.
11. Look into the camera when you are speaking.

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- 12. Speak clearly and slowly.
- 13. To avoid shadows, avoid sitting in front of a window or avoid a light source visible on your screen. The best background is a solid background or wall.
- 14. Be respectful and minimize interruptions unless attempting to object.
- 15. Please remain focused on your hearing.
- 16. Please ensure that every witness or lawyer participating has a separate camera and microphone (or separate laptop) even if in the same room. Try to avoid sharing a laptop to ensure the best sound quality.
