This 22 contested case was consolidated with CV6417-33-9005 and litigation begun. The litigation 23 appears to have ceased in 1994 without decision. By Order dated August 17, 2022, this case has 24 been separated from and is no longer consolidated with CV6417-33-9005. All further 2.5 proceedings in this case will be filed under case number CV6417-33-6828.

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This contested case is one of the many cases in the Arizona General Stream Adjudication for the Silver Creek Watershed to adjudicate legal rights to water. The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the rights of those persons who filed Statements of Claimant for rights to use appropriable water in Arizona. The General Adjudication will also determine water rights for the Hopi Reservation, the Navajo Reservation, and other watersheds included in the Little Colorado River Watershed.

The United States Forest Service ("Claimant") filed Statement of Claimant ("SOC") 39-91644 on July 5, 1990, for rights to water from Show Low Creek drainage area. According to the SOC, the place of use is in Township 9N Range 22E. The Statement of Claimant asserts a claimed right of one miner's inch per year of water from Porter Creek and Porter Spring. The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated the claim, which it characterized as a claim for irrigation and stock and wildlife watering uses. It prepared a report known as Watershed File Report No. 033-56-ACAA-001 ("WFR") published in the Final Silver Creek Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (November 30, 1990) ("Silver Creek HSR"). A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment A.

Arizona Department of Water Resources identified a potential water right to divert 1.3 cubic feet per second ("cfs") from Show Low Creek with a maximum demand rate of 1.5 cfs. It also proposed a potential water right to irrigate 74.3 acres with 208 acre feet of water for deficit irrigation and 408.6 acre-feet of water for average efficient irrigation. A copy of the map showing the place of use prepared by ADWR is attached as Attachment B.

After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR by the Arizona State Land Department, Phelps Dodge, and Salt River Project. The purpose of this case is to consider the claims made for water rights that are the subject of the WFR and resolve the objections to the WFR.

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IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Contested Case. This contested case shall be known as In re FS-Apache Sitgreaves and it will determine appropriable water rights asserted in the Statement of Claimant and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report No. 033-56-ACAA-001 published in the Final Silver Creek Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1990). - 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant and all persons who filed objections to the WFR, and parties who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment C to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Apache County

 Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the

 Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Court will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list.

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4. <u>Status Conference.</u> A status conference shall be held to set procedures to complete the adjudication of the rights claimed in this case. Claimant shall be prepared by the status conference to identify any issues that have been decided and the issues that remain to be resolved. The telephonic Status Conference shall be held on **September 29**, 2022 at 2:30 p.m. The Status Conference shall be held using the Court Connect program. 
