9:29 a.m. This is the time set for a Status Conference before Special Master Susan Ward Harris in the above cases. Counsel, Monique Coady is present on behalf of the City of Phoenix. Counsel, Carla Consoli is present on behalf of The Arizona Chapter of the Nature Conservancy. Counsel, Mark McGinnis is present on behalf of the Salt River Project.

Appearing telephonically are Counsel Susan Montgomery on behalf of the Pascua Yaqui Tribe and Yavapai-Apache Nation; Counsel Kimberly Parks on behalf of the Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR); and Counsel Joe Sparks appearing on behalf of the San Carlos Apache Tribe and Tonto Apache Tribe. Counsel David Brown appears telephonically for observation purposes only.

Court reporter Celeste Paxton Jones is present and a record of the proceedings is also made digitally.

Ms. Consoli reports to the Court on the status of what has been accomplished to amend the water claims asserted on behalf of the Nature Conservancy. Analysis is being done on the ADWR well files, as well as identification and location of stock ponds. Ms. Consoli is working on tracking historical claims and comparing those claims with current uses and is working with Jeff Trembly at ADWR on a plan to correct discrepancies in the historical record.

Discussion is held with Court regarding the status of in-stream flow cases, the number, location, and legal description of stockponds and wells, watershed file reports, irrigation claims, and whether BLM will be making claims as to the stockponds. Issue was also raised as to whether all or a portion of the cases should be consolidated. Counsel for The Nature Conservancy requested that no decision should be made at this time.

Ms. Consoli will make a public records request to ADWR for a list of open WFRs and will provide Mr. Trembly with a list of wells.

Based on this information, the only Statements of Claimant (SOC) that involve BLM land are the two SOCs identified in 115-05-AC-010: SOCs 39-0336 and 39-5509. Jose Tapia originally filed 39-0336. Defenders of Wildlife filed 39-5509 and subsequently assigned it to The Nature Conservancy. The location of use for both SOCs is NE NW 28 T6S R19E.

These cases do not include claims to water rights analyzed by WFRs 115-05-05, 115-05-17, 115-05-18, and 115-05-19. These WFRs analyze a series of SOCs for use on land identified as owned by BLM and leased by The Nature Conservancy. According to the records maintained by Arizona Department of Water Resources, the Nature Conservancy assigned its Statements of Claimant identified in those WFRs to BLM except for SOC 39-002644, originally filed by E.G. Salazar for 134 acre feet of water for stock watering at a location identified by ADWR as NWNESW 19 T6S R19E. The Nature Conservancy assigned a number of its claims to BLM pursuant to that Assignment of Statement of Claimant, filed June 23, 1992 (relevant parts of which are shown on the following pages).

IT IS ORDERED that the United States shall file by **January 31, 2018**, a report concerning its position on the claims for water uses analyzed in WFR 115-05-AC-010 including its position on the ownership of any water rights awarded pursuant to those claims.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Responses to The Nature Conservancy's Amended Statements of Claimant and report shall be filed by the Objectors in this case by **March 30, 2018**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a status conference shall be held on April 4, 2018, at 1:30 p.m. in the Superior Court of Arizona, Central Court Building, Courtroom 301, 201 West Jefferson Street, Phoenix, AZ 85003-2202.
