The Court will remove the landowners that have failed to appear twice from the Court-Approved mailing list after the distribution of this minute entry. There were a few landowners that appeared at the Status Conference on March 5, 2024; therefore, the Court will provide a deadline for the parties to meet with ADWR, submit their fillings and obtain assignments.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that that by June 28, 2024, Mr. Jack Peterson, Mr. David Peterson, and Sherry Columbia shall each file with the Court written statements explaining their failure to appear on March 5, 2024, and provide to the Court evidence of filing with ADWR updated SOCs and an estimate of the time needed to file the appropriate basis of right of application. Failure to provide the documentation as ordered by the Court shall result in the dismissal of any potential claim(s) for this contested case.
