Status conference set for March 2, 2023 at 2:30 p.m. 18 19 NUMBER OF PAGES: 13 20 DATE OF FILING: January 18, 2023 21 **General Explanation** 22 This Order continues the process necessary to adjudicate claims made for rights to 23 appropriable water on land formerly owned by Jefferson Larson and currently owned by 24 Wheatfield and Frog Island, LLC. This contested case was initially consolidated with CV 6417-25 33-9002 and subsequently consolidated with CV 6417-33-9005. No activity in this case appears 26 27

to have occurred after 1994 and no decision was entered. By Order dated January 17, 2023, this case has been separated from and is no longer consolidated with CV 6417-33-9005.

This contested case is one of the many cases in the Arizona General Stream Adjudication for the Silver Creek Watershed to determine legal rights to water. The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the rights of those persons who filed Statements of Claimant for rights to use appropriable water in Arizona. The General Adjudication will also determine water rights for the Hopi Reservation, the Navajo Reservation, and other watersheds included in the Little Colorado River Watershed.

In this case, Jefferson J. Larson and Alice C. Larson ("Claimants") filed Statement of Claimant ("SOC") 39-88374 on October 1, 1985 for rights to water for use on land in the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 26, Township 9N Range 22E. The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated the claim, which it characterized as a claim for irrigation, stockpond, and other uses, and prepared a report known as Watershed File Report No. 033-56-ACDB-026 ("WFR") published in the Final Silver Creek Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment A, and a copy of the map showing the parcel investigated by ADWR is attached as Attachment B. The relevant parcel is labeled "(26)."

The SOC includes claims for eight acre-feet annually of water for irrigation use and 20 acre-feet for storage with a priority date of September 26, 1985 from a diversion located in SWSWNW section 26 T9N, R22E. The WFR found an irrigation use on the land described in the WFR. After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR by the United States, joined by the Navajo Nation and the Hopi Tribe, and Salt River Project. The purpose of this case is to consider the claims made for water rights that are the subject of the WFR and resolve the objections to the WFR.

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Claimant & Landowners

The WFR identified one SOC relevant to the potential water right: 39-88374. Jefferson and Alice Larson filed the SOC claiming water for irrigation and storage uses. The WFR lists Jefferson J. Larson as the owner of the property described as located in the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 26, Township 9N Range 22E.

The records of the Navajo County Assessor indicate that Wheatfield and Frog Island, LLC is now the current owner of the land described in the WFR, which comprises tax parcel no. 212-31-011. The records of the Navajo County Recorder show that in 2005, Jefferson and Alice Larson transferred tax parcel no. 212-31-011 to Wheatfield and Frog Island, LLC. A copy of the map prepared by the Navajo County Assessor showing tax parcel no. 212-31-011 is attached as Attachment C.

The public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not contain an assignment of the SOC from Jefferson J. Larson to the current landowner, and the current landowner has not filed a SOC.

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Contested Case. This contested case shall be known as In Jefferson J. Larson, and it will determine appropriable water rights asserted in the Statement of Claimant and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report 033-56-ACDB-026 published in the Final Silver Creek Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). - Litigants. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimants, all persons who
 filed objections to the WFR, the current landowner, and parties who are allowed to intervene by
 order.

Court-Approved Mailing List.

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment C to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Apache County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Court will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list.
- 4. <u>Status Conference.</u> An initial status conference shall be held to determine whether the current landowner, Wheatfield and Frog Island, LLC, intends to pursue claims for rights to appropriable water for irrigation use. If no person claiming a water right appears at the Status Conference, then Statement of Claimant 39-88374 and this case will be dismissed, and no further action will be taken with respect to the WFR or the objections filed to the WFR.

The Status Conference shall be held on March 2, 2023 at 2:30 p.m. The Status Conference shall be held using the Court Connect program. Instructions for Court Connect are attached as Attachment E. 
