In this case, six (6) Statements of Claimant ("SOCs"), 39-2420, 39-2421, 39-2437,
39-8050, 39-8103, and 39-8360 were filed by the United States Forest Service and
Umpire Ranch Partnership to assert claims to use water on land in Sections 31, 32, and
33 in Township 21S, Range 18E.

The first step in this case will be an initial conference, where landowners will state whether they intend to pursue water rights.

Additional background information on the process for determining water rights in Arizona can be found on Attachment A.

13 Details of the Case

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The SOCs claimed rights to use surface water for stockpond and instream stock
watering purposes.

The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated the claims
made by the Claimants and prepared Watershed File Report No. 111-19-020 ("WFR"),
published in the Final San Pedro Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991) ("San
Pedro HSR"). The WFR recorded that surface water from the Babocomari River was
being used for stockpond and instream stock watering purposes. A copy of the WFR is
attached as Attachment B.

After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the
WFR by the United States, the Gila River Indian Community, San Carlos Apache Tribe,
Tonto Apache Tribe, the Yavapai-Apache Nation of the Camp Verde Indian Reservation,
and Salt River Project.

26 || Claimant and Landowners

The WFR lists the U.S. Forest Service as the owner of the property investigated
and Umpire Ranch Partnership as the lessee. According to information provided by

1 ADWR, the land investigated for WFR 111-19-020 appears to comprise portions of 2 sections 29, 30, 31, 32, 33 of Township 21S, Range 18E.

3 A copy of a map, provided by ADWR, showing the boundaries of the investigation 4 area is attached as Attachment C.

The public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not contain any assignments of the SOC listed in the WFR, and landowners and lessees do not appear to have filed any SOCs since the filing of the San Pedro Hydrographic Survey Report.

8 To pursue water rights, a property owner must file a Statement of Claimant and 9 present to the Court evidence of the existence of a water right on their property. This 10 evidence may include the WFR. If either the property owner proves to the Court the 11 existence of water rights on their property or enters into a valid settlement approved by 12 the Court, the Court will recognize enforceable water rights in a "Final Decree." Ariz. 13 Rev. Stat. § 45-257(B).

14 This is an Order from the Court. All parties must comply with the following 15 instructions. The failure to obey this, or any, court order may result in the dismissal of 16 this case and the loss of any potential water rights associated with the properties 17 mentioned in this Order. ATTACHMENT A

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General Background on the Water Rights Determination Process in Arizona

A general stream adjudication is a judicial proceeding to determine the quantity and priority of all water rights in a river system. Arizona is undertaking general stream adjudications of both the Gila River and the Little Colorado River systems. A river system includes surface water flowing "in streams or other natural channels," groundwater sufficiently connected to that surface water, and water subject to claims by the federal government. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-251(7). Recognizing and respecting water rights and the priority of such rights is important in Arizona where times of drought or water scarcity can occur.

All cases begin with the filing of a "Statement of Claimant," ("SOC") in which a property
owner makes a claim for a right to use surface water on their property. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45254(A). This person is the "claimant." The SOCs contain, among other characteristics, a
description of the source and quantity of the water used, the location of use, the location from
which the water was diverted, and the date when the water was first put to use. *Id.* § 45-254(C).

After the property owner files the SOCs, the Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") prepares a "Watershed File Report," ("WFR") in which ADWR investigates the claims in the SOCs and recommends water rights associated with the property. *Id.* § 45-256(B). ADWR compiles all WFRs for a watershed into a comprehensive Hydrographic Survey Report ("HSR") and publishes the report for public review and comment. In response, other claimants in the Adjudication may file "objections" disputing the information or recommendations in the WFR. The individuals who file objections are called "objectors."

This "contested case", one of thousands in the Gila River System, will evaluate claims asserted in specific Statements of Claimant while considering objections to the WFR that reported ADWR's initial inspection of those claims.


