This contested case arises from Watershed File Report 111-20-065 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). It states that Arizona Department of Water Resources found no irrigation or domestic uses of water and recommended no potential water uses. Gila River Indian Community, San Carlos Apache Tribe, Yavapai-Apache Indian Community, Camp Verde Reservation, United States Department of the Interior-

Bureau of Land Management, BLM-San Pedro Riparian National Conservation Area, and BLM-Phoenix District Office filed objections to Watershed File Report 111-20-065. This contested case was subsequently consolidated with *In re San Pedro Riparian National Conservation Area*, contested case W1-11-232. *See* Case Management Order, September 26, 2006.

During the Status Conference on August 22, 2022 in W1-11-0232, the United States represented that it did not intend to pursue any water rights within the borders of the land that was the subject of Watershed File Report 111-20-065. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that this contested case is severed from *In re SPRNCA*, contested case W1-11-0232.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no further action shall be taken with respect to the objections to Watershed File Report 111-20-065.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this case is dismissed.
