Copies of this order are also being sent to Thomas and Robert Manteufel. 26

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This contested case is one of the many cases in the General Stream Adjudication for the San Pedro River watershed to determine legal rights to water. Other cases in which claims have been made for legal rights to water in the San Pedro River watershed have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or are awaiting initiation. The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the rights of those persons who filed statement of claimants for rights to use appropriable water in the San Pedro River Watershed. The General Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria, and Upper Santa Cruz watersheds.

In this case, Ruth M. Ryan ("Claimant") filed a Statement of Claimant on January 2, 1985, for rights to use water for irrigation on land that she described as 23.033 acres of land in Section 32 Township 20S Range 20E, consisting of two tax parcels. She identified the relevant land as tax parcels 106-47-032-4 and 106-47-032A-3 encompassing 21.033 and 2 acres, respectively. A copy of the map attached to the SOC is attached as Attachment A. Mrs. Ryan listed the source of water as a well registered under registration no. 55-612340. The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated the claim and prepared a report known as Watershed File Report No. 111-20-CA-006 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey WFR (1991). A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment B. It did not prepare a map showing the land investigated.

The WFR stated that ADWR found no uses of water and no sources of water on the land. After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR. The purpose of this case is to consider the claims made for water rights that are the subject of the WFR and resolve the objections to the WFR.

Claimant & Landowners

The WFR identified Statement of Claimant (SOC) 39-11856 as the relevant claim. It listed Ruth M. Ryan as the owner of the property described as located in Section 23 T20S R20E

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with the water diverted from SWSWSW section 32 T20S R20E. The public records maintained by ADWR do not include an assignment of the SOC to a successor landowner. The public records maintained by ADWR also do not include any change in the registration of the ownership of the well identified by Mrs. Ryan as the source of the water.

According to the Cochise Country Treasurer, tax parcel 106-47-032-4 was combined in 2020 with tax parcel 106-47-06706 to create tax parcel 106-47-032H. Terry Filloon is listed as the current owner of tax parcel 106-47-032H that consists of 21.033 acres. Similarly, the Cochise County Treasurer no longer has a tax parcel 106-47-032A-3. The legal description for tax parcel 106-47-032A-3 provided by Mrs. Ryan was for a two-acre parcel in section 32 T20 S R20 E. On May 7, 1996, a Community Property with the Right of Survivorship Deed was recorded with the Cochise County Recorder naming Ruth M. Ryan as the grantor and Thomas W. Manteufel and Doris J. Manteufel as the grantees of that two-acre parcel of land in Section 32 Township 20 S Range 20E with a legal description found on the tax bill submitted by Mrs. Ryan with the SOC. See Deed recorded at document #1996-11641. Thereafter, Thomas and Doris Manteufel signed a Joint Tenancy Deed in favor of Robert and Janice Manteufel that appears to include land received in the Community Property with the Right of Survivorship Deed. See Joint Tenancy Deed filed with the Cochise County Recorder on April 17, 1997, at document #1997-09702. The Cochise County Treasurer lists Thomas Manteufel and Robert Manteufel as the owners of tax parcels 106-47-032D and 106-47-032G, respectively. A copy of the map prepared by the Cochise Country Treasurer is attached as Attachment C.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Ruth M. Ryan* and it will address the Statement of Claimant and objections that were filed to Watershed File report 111-20-CA-006 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be found under the case name and number on the following website:

2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, the current landowners, all persons who filed objections to the WFR, who are included on Attachment D, and parties who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County

 Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the

 Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Court will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list.

 Upon request, the Clerk of the Court will provide copies by email. Parties may request emailed copies of minute entries and orders by completing and submitting a CONSENT FOR ELECTRONIC RECEIPT OF WATER CASE DOCUMENTS, which is attached as Attachment E.

4. <u>Status Conference.</u> An initial status conference shall be held to determine whether the Claimant or the current landowners intend to pursue claims for rights to appropriable water. If neither the Claimant nor any successor landowner appears at the Status Conference, then Statement of Claimant 39-11856 and this case will be dismissed and no further action will be taken with respect to the WFR or the objections filed to the WFR.

The Status Conference shall be held on October 27, 2022 at 1:30 p.m. The Status Conference shall be held using the Court Connect program. Instructions for Court Connect are attached as Attachment F. 


