By Order dated December 6, 2021, this contested 25 case was severed from In re San Pedro Riparian National Conservation Area. This Order begins 26 27

the process necessary to adjudicate claims for rights under state law to appropriable water for land that the Cochise County Assessor has identified as owned by Casa de la Orilla LLC.

First National Bank of Arizona and Charles J. Leftault as Co-trustees ("Claimants") filed a Statement of Claimant on July 13, 1984 for rights to use water for a stock pond and irrigation purposes. The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated those claims and prepared a report known as Watershed File Report No. 111-24-CBB-005 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map prepared by ADWR is attached as Attachment B on which the land is labelled as "(5)".

The WFR found an irrigation use on land in SWNW Section 15 Township 23S Range 22E. After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR. The purpose of this case is to consider the claims made for water rights that are the subject of the WFR and resolve the objections to the WFR.

The Arizona Department of Water Resources identified a well as the source of water for the claimed use. It has determined that the well is within the subflow zone. The Cochise County Assessor shows the land as tax parcel 104-34-002B owned by Casa de la Orilla LLC. A copy of the map prepared by the Cochise County Assessor is attached as Attachment C.

### **Claimant & Landowners**

The WFR identified one Statement of Claimant (SOC) relevant to the potential water right: 39-2258. The WFR lists Robert W. Boucher as the owner of the property described in the WFR. The public records maintained by the ADWR do not include an assignment of the SOC from the Claimant to the successor landowner. The records of the Cochise County Assessor list Casa de la Orilla LLC as the current owner of the property described in the WFR. The public records also do not include a Statement of Claimant filed by Casa de la Orilla LLC.

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### IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Contested Case. This contested case shall be known as In re Robert W. Boucher and it will determine appropriable water rights asserted in the Statement of Claimant and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report 111-24-CBB-005 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). - 2. Litigants. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, the current landowners, all persons who filed objections to the WFR, who are included on Attachment C, and parties who are allowed to intervene by order. On December 3, 2021 William P. Sullivan filed Motion to Withdraw as Attorney of Record for Bella Vista LTD Partnership, Bella Vista Ranches LTD Partnership and Daniel Cracchiolo with Consent. The motion, which was granted via Order dated December 6, 2021, requests that William P. Sullivan, PLLC, Bella Vista LTD Partnership, Bella Vista Ranches LTD Partnership, and Daniel Cracchiolo not be included in the court approved mailing list for this contested case.

#### 3. Court-Approved Mailing List.

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Courtapproved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Court-approved mailing list.

- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties who are allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Court will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list.

  Upon request, the Clerk of the Court will provide copies by email. Parties may request emailed copies of minute entries and orders by completing and submitting a CONSENT FOR ELECTRONIC RECEIPT OF WATER CASE DOCUMENTS, which is attached as Attachment E.
- 4. <u>Notice.</u> Casa de la Orilla LLC shall file a Notice upon receipt of documents requested from the National Archives. The Notice shall include the estimated amount of time necessary to file forms with Arizona Department of Water Resources and amount of time estimated to contact and discuss objections with Objectors.




