Mr. Brown states that his client intends to assert a water right, and requests that this matter be stayed until September 16, 2022, so his client can get the probate action underway.

Mr. Johnson intends to assert a water right as well, and also requests that this matter be stayed for the reason that his well is outside the red line of the subflow zone. Mr. Johnson intends to file a statement of claimant as soon as he hires counsel to assist him.

As there are no objections to the request for a stay,

IT IS ORDERED granting a stay in this matter until September 16, 2022.

The Court explains the process of the stay to Mr. Johnson and what he can expect moving forward.
