24 25 26 27 28	This case involves potential water rights for irrigation associated with a domestic use in the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 34 Township 16S Range 20E. The purpose of this case is to resolve the objections to Watershed File Report 112-17-BAA-037 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). A copy
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1 of the Watershed File Report 112-17-BAA-037 ("WFR") is attached as Attachment A. A copy 2 of the map prepared by Arizona Department of Water Resources that identifies the land 3 investigated for the WFR is attached as Attachment B and the land involved is labelled on the 4 map as "(37)" with a red arrow pointing to it. The WFR lists the source of water as a diversion 5 from the San Pedro River into the Pomerene Water Users Association Canal. The WFR does not 6 list any Statements of Claimant or any other filings with Arizona Department of Water Resources 7 to obtain rights to appropriable water. The purpose of this case is to resolve the objections to the 8 potential water rights to the extent that the current landowners intend to pursue them.

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10 Background

11 Until October 5, 2018, this case was consolidated with and a part of the group of cases 12 known as In re Pomerene Water Users Association, contested case no. W1-11-1676. In that 13 case, the court scheduled a status conference for June 28, 2017 in part to identify the proper 14 parties. At the status conference, counsel for the Pomerene Water Users Association was given 15 until October 2, 2017 to provide documentation concerning the continuing authority of 16 17 Pomerene Water Users Association to act. No landowners appeared at the status conference.

18 By order dated July 26, 2017, the court directed the owners of the land for which 19 Arizona Department of Water Resources had identified as places of use for water diverted 20 through the Pomerene Canal to file new or amended statements of claimant if they desired to 21 assert a claim for a right to divert water through the Pomerene Canal for irrigation use. A second 22 status conference was set for October 18, 2017. A copy of the order was sent to Thomas and 23 24 Sharon Harding. 25

At the status conference held on October 18, 2017, the newly elected board of the 26 Pomerene Water Users Association appeared along with its counsel. The court directed the Pomerene Water Users Association to file a list by December 29, 2017 that identified those

landowners who were members of the Pomerene Water Users Association and whose interests
would be represented by the Pomerene Water Users Association in this adjudication of water
rights. The court also set a third status conference for September 6, 2018. On December 21,
2017, the Pomerene Water Users Association timely filed a list of 26 landowners. Thomas and
Sharon Harding were not included in the list of the represented landowners.

On August 31, 2018, Pomerene Water Users Association filed a Notice of Termination. At the third status conference, counsel for the Pomerene Water Users Association provided a list of its members who joined the St. David Irrigation District. Thomas and Sharon Harding were not included on the list and they did not appear at the status conference.

By order dated October 5, 2018, the cases previously consolidated into a single case known as *In re Pomerene Water Users Association* were separated into individual cases. As a result, the potential water rights analyzed in the WFR will be considered in this separate case.

🗧 🛛 Landowners

The first step to adjudicate the water rights identified by the WFR is to identify the current
 landowners involved in this case. Based on the WFR, the land involved includes the following
 tax parcel: 20843010. According to the Cochise County Assessor's Office the current owners of
 this tax parcel are Thomas and Sharon Harding. Attached as Attachment C is a map showing tax
 parcel 20843010 from the Cochise County Assessor's Office.

On April 25, 1994, the Pomerene Water Users Association filed Statement of Claimant 39-14898 for irrigation use with a priority date of September 10, 1879 that included land in Section 34 Township 16S Range 20E. The WFR in this contested case include land in Section 34 Township 16S Range 20E. Thomas and Sharon Harding have not filed a Statement of Claimant for a right to appropriable water. Accordingly,

4. <u>Status Conference.</u>


- A. An initial status conference shall be held to determine whether Thomas and Sharon Harding intend to pursue claims for rights to appropriable water. If Thomas and Sharon Harding do not appear at the Status Conference, this case shall be dismissed. If Thomas and Sharon Harding appear and seek water rights they shall be prepared at the Status Conference to provide information about efforts undertaken to file a Statement of Claimant.
- B. If Thomas and Sharon Harding intend to pursue rights to appropriable water for use on the land, they will be expected to advise whether they are interested in pursuing discussions to resolve the objections to the WFR and the amount of time that the parties believe will be necessary to complete those discussions.
- C. If the objections cannot be settled, then a subsequent date will be set for a scheduling conference to identify issues, file disclosure statements, conduct discovery, submit prehearing motions, and hold a trial. No party shall conduct any discovery or file any motions prior to the Status Conference.
- The Status Conference shall be held on **January 20, 2022 at 2:00 p.m**. The Status Conference shall be held using the Court Connect program. 
