Initial conference set for May 23, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. 19 NUMBER OF PAGES: 18 20 **General Explanation** 21 This order opens a case to determine rights to use water on land owned by Carron 22 Elford, Catherine Lasher, William Roseberry, Annette Johansen, Marcus Tucker, 23 Kimberly and Paul Skolkin, Seth Wilson and Chelsy Hinton, and Marm LLC. 24 The first step in this case is an initial conference with the Court, scheduled for 2.5 May 23, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. to determine if landowners are interested in pursuing 26 potential water rights. Interested Parties MUST attend the scheduled initial conference if 27 they plan to pursue potential water rights. Failure to appear at the initial conference could 28

result in the dismissal of the case and the loss of water rights associated with the properties.

In this case, four Statements of Claimant ("SOCs"), 39-3888, 39-6572, 39-11756, and 39-11757, were filed between June 1980 and January 1985 by Max J. Kartchner, Robert Prater, and Rancho Rio Vista to assert claims to use water on land in Sections 14 and 23 of Township 17 South, Range 20 East.

The first step in this case will be an initial conference, where landowners will state whether they intend to pursue water rights.

Additional background information on the process for determining water rights in Arizona can be found on Attachment A.

Details of the Case

The various SOCs filed claim rights to use groundwater for domestic, irrigation, and stockpond purposes.

The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated the claims made by the Claimant and prepared Watershed File Report No. 112-17-BDA-004 ("WFR"), published in the Final San Pedro Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991) ("San Pedro HSR"). The WFR recorded that wells in SESESE Section 14 and NWSENE Section 23 Township 17 South, Range 20 East were being used for domestic and irrigation purposes and to supply small reservoirs. The WFR recorded that surface water of the San Pedro River was being used for stockpond purposes.

ADWR also published a map of the area investigated, denoted by "(4)." A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment B, and a copy of the map is attached as Attachment C.

After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR by the United States, ASARCO, Magma Copper, the Gila River Indian Community, San Carlos Apache Tribe, Tonto Apache Tribe, the Yavapai-Apache Nation, the Camp

Verde Reservation, and the Salt River Project.

Claimant and Landowners

The WFR lists Rancho Rio Vista as the owner of the property investigated.

Ine WFR lists Rancho Rio Vista as the owner of the property investigated. According to maps provided by ADWR and the Cochise County Assessor ("Assessor"), the land investigated appears to comprise Cochise County tax parcels 123-37-005Y, 123-37005X, 123-37-006G, 123-37-006F, 123-37-005V, 123-37-005W, 123-37-005S, 123-37-005D, 123-37-005E, 123-37-005F, 123-37-005G, 123-37-007, and 124-18-013.

A copy of a map, provided by ADWR, showing the boundaries of the investigation area is attached as attachment D. A map showing the relevant tax parcels and the current owners, the San Pedro River subflow zone, and the approximate location of the wells supplying the domestic and irrigation uses detailed in the WFR is attached as Attachment E.

The public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not contain any assignments of the SOC listed in the WFR, and the current landowners do not appear to have filed any additional SOCs.

To pursue water rights, a property owner must file a Statement of Claimant and present to the Court evidence of the existence of a water right on their property. This evidence may include the WFR. If either the property owner proves to the Court the existence of water rights on their property or enters into a valid settlement approved by the Court, the Court will recognize enforceable water rights in a "Final Decree." Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-257(B).

This is an Order from the Court. All parties must comply with the following instructions. The failure to obey this, or any, court order may result in the dismissal of this case and the loss of any potential water rights associated with the properties mentioned in this Order. If you have questions regarding this order or any of the attachments, please contact the General Stream Adjudication, Office of the Special Water Master, at (602) 372-4115. Please note that staff can only answer administrative questions and cannot provide legal advice.

2 IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. <u>Case Initiation</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Rancho Rio Vista*, and it will resolve claims to appropriable water asserted in Statements of Claimant 39-3888, 39-6572, 39-11756, and 38-11757 and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report No. 112-17-BDA-004.
- 2. <u>Initial Conference.</u> An initial conference shall be held on May 23, 2024 at 10:00 a.m.. to determine whether current landowners intend to pursue claims for water rights. The conference will be held using the Court Connect program. Instructions for Court Connect are attached as Attachment G. If you receive this order by email, click on the red box "Join Court Connect Hearing" on the attached instructions to make an appearance. If you do not receive this order by email, log into the Court Connect program on the internet by typing https://tinyurl.com/specialwatermaster. If you do not have access to the internet, you may attend telephonically using the telephone number and access code included in the instructions for Court Connect.
- 3. <u>Parties</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the original claimants, the current landowners, and any party who filed an objection to the Watershed File Report. The objectors in this case are the United States, ASARCO, Magma Copper, the Gila River Indian Community, San Carlos Apache Tribe, Tonto Apache Tribe, the Yavapai-Apache Nation, the Camp Verde Reservation, and the Salt River Project. Note that no claimant currently owns any parcel relevant to this contested case.
- 4. <u>Objections</u>. Copies of the objections filed to WFR No. 112-17-BDA-004 can be found under the case number W1-11-1983 on the following website: http://www.superiorcourt.maricopa.gov/SuperiorCourt/GeneralStreamAdjudication/whatsNew.asp.
- 5. Court-Approved Mailing List.

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment F to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County
 Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed
 on the Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Court will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list.

ATTACHMENT A

General Background on the Water Rights Determination Process in Arizona

A general stream adjudication is a judicial proceeding to determine the quantity and priority of all water rights in a river system. Arizona is undertaking general stream adjudications of both the Gila River and the Little Colorado River systems. A river system includes surface water flowing "in streams or other natural channels," groundwater sufficiently connected to that surface water, and water subject to claims by the federal government. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-251(7). Recognizing and respecting water rights and the priority of such rights is important in Arizona where times of drought or water scarcity can occur.

All cases begin with the filing of a "Statement of Claimant," ("SOC") in which a property owner makes a claim for a right to use surface water on their property. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-254(A). This person is the "claimant." The SOCs contain, among other characteristics, a description of the source and quantity of the water used, the location of use, the location from which the water was diverted, and the date when the water was first put to use. *Id.* § 45-254(C).

After the property owner files the SOCs, the Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") prepares a "Watershed File Report," ("WFR") in which ADWR investigates the claims in the SOCs and recommends water rights associated with the property. *Id.* § 45-256(B). ADWR compiles all WFRs for a watershed into a comprehensive Hydrographic Survey Report ("HSR") and publishes the report for public review and comment. In response, other claimants in the Adjudication may file "objections" disputing the information or recommendations in the WFR. The individuals who file objections are called "objectors."

This "contested case", one of thousands in the Gila River System, will evaluate claims asserted in specific Statements of Claimant while considering objections to the WFR that reported ADWR's initial inspection of those claims.






WFR Map




