This contested case is one of the many cases in the General Stream Adjudication for the San Pedro River Watershed to determine legal rights to water. Other cases in which claims have been made for legal rights to water in the San Pedro River Watershed have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or are awaiting initiation. The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the rights of those persons who filed statements of claimant for rights to use appropriable water in Arizona. The General Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria, and Upper Santa Cruz watersheds.

In this case, Robert E. Darnell filed Statement of Claimant ("SOC") 39-2269 on December 31, 1979 for 10 acre-feet-annually of water for irrigation use on ten acres in the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section 21 T18S R21E. According to the tax statement filed with the Statement of Claimant, the ten acres are located in the north half of the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 21, T18 R 21 and was known as tax parcel 121-28-004. The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated the claim and found no irrigation use on the land described in the SOC. It described the results of its investigation in the WFR. A copy of the WFR is included as Attachment A. The public records of Arizona Department of Water Resources do not contain an assignment of Statement of Claimant 39-2269.

The WFR found no use of water on the land and no sources of water for use on the land it investigated. After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR. The purpose of this case is to consider the claims made for water rights that are the subject of the WFR and resolve the objections to the WFR.

The Cochise County Assessor has identified the individuals and entities shown in Table 1 as the relevant owners of land in the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 21 Township 18S Range 21E who are associated with tax parcel 121-28-004. A map prepared by the Cochise County Assessor is attached as Attachment B.

The public records maintained by ADWR contains Statement of Claimant 36-16769 filed by Heather Diane Borman and registrations for two wells: 55-214906 filed in 2007 and 55-528641 filed September 1990.

- 1. Contested Case. This contested case shall be known as In re Robert E. Darnell and it will determine appropriable water rights asserted in the Statement of Claimant and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report 112-17-BD-054 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be found under the case name and number the following website: on http://www.superiorcourt.maricopa.gov/SuperiorCourt/GeneralStreamAdjudication/whatsNew. asp
- 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, the current landowners, all persons who filed objections to the Watershed File Report who are listed on Attachment C, and parties who are allowed to intervene by order.
 - 3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment C to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Courtapproved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Court will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list. Upon request, the Clerk of the Court will provide copies by email. Parties may request emailed copies of minute entries and orders by completing and submitting a CONSENT FOR ELECTRONIC RECEIPT OF WATER CASE DOCUMENTS, which is attached as Attachment D.

4. Status Conference.

- A. An initial status conference shall be held to determine whether the Claimant and the current landowners, intend to pursue claims for rights to appropriable water. If so, the parties seeking water rights shall be prepared at the Status Conference to provide information about efforts undertaken to assign or file a Statement of Claimant.
- B. If the Claimant or current landowners intend to pursue rights to appropriable water for use on the land, the parties will be expected to

advise whether they are interested in pursuing discussions to resolve the objections to the WFR and the amount of time that the parties believe will be necessary to complete those discussions.

C. If the objections cannot be settled, then a subsequent date will be set for a scheduling conference to identify issues, file disclosure statements, conduct discovery, submit prehearing motions, and hold a trial. No party shall conduct any discovery or file any motions prior to the Status Conference.

The Status Conference shall be held on January 20, 2022 at 1:40 p.m. The Status Conference shall be held using the Court Connect program. Instructions for Court Connect are attached as Attachment E. 
