This case will adjudicate the claims for water rights and resolve objections to Watershed File Report and Zone 2 Well Report 112-17-DBA-322 (collectively "Report") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The Report identified potential water rights for irrigation use for land located in Section 5 Township 18S Range 21E. The identified sources of water for the identified use are two wells operated by the St. David Irrigation District and surface water from the San Pedro River. A copy of the Report is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map prepared for the Report is attached as Attachment B.

The Report does not identify any Statements of Claimant. St. David Irrigation District filed Statements of Claimant 39-6593 and 39-6594 that include land located in Section 5 Township 18S Range 21E in its description of "Place of Use." Arizona Department of Water Resources prepared Watershed File Report 112-17-088 that discussed the results of its investigation of the water uses on the land shown on Attachment B.


The St. David Irrigation District has identified the land as Cochise County tax parcels 121-09-006B, 121-09-006C, and 121-09-006J. The public records of Cochise County Assessor's Office identify Sarena Lynn and Brian James Williams, Jeremy V. and Janine F. Wiley, and Emerson B. & Wendy Gooding as the owners of tax parcels 121-09-066B, 121-09-006C, and 121-09-006J, respectively. Copies of the maps prepared by the Cochise County Assessor showing tax parcel nos. 121-09-006B, 121-09-006C, and 121-09-006J are attached as Attachment C. A copy of a map prepared by Arizona Department of Water Resources listing the tax parcel numbers associated with the Watershed File Report is attached as Attachment D.
