[¶1]The Court, having reviewed the State of North Dakota's Application for Injunction and Order to Compel ("Application") and all the papers on file, rules as follows:

[¶2]Based on the law and facts presented, the Court is satisfied Respondent has without good cause or reason failed to respond to the Attorney General's January 17, 2018 Civil Investigative Demand issued by the Attorney General pursuant to N.D.C.C. §§ 51-15-04 and 51-15-05.

[¶3]The State of North Dakota's Application is hereby GRANTED and NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that:

- a. Cherri Lynn Rolla, doing business as Watch Me Performance Horses, within fifteen (15) days of the Court's order, must fully comply with the Attorney General's January 17, 2018 Civil Investigative Demand.
- b. Pursuant to N.D.C.C. § 51-15-06, Cherri Lynn Rolla, doing business as Watch Me Performance Horses, her agents, employees, representatives, successors, assigns, and all other persons in active concert or

participation with her, is enjoined from directly or indirectly engaging in any solicitation or sale of services or merchandise, as defined by N.D.C.C. § 51-15-01, including the sale of animals, in the State of North Dakota.

- c. The injunction shall remain in place until Cherri Lynn Rolla, doing business as Watch Me Performance Horses, fully complies with the Attorney General's January 17, 2018 Civil Investigative Demand and until the injunction is terminated by further order of this Court.
- d. Pursuant to N.D.C.C. § 51-15-10, Respondent shall pay \$ 519.89 to the Attorney General for the reasonable costs, expenses, and attorney's fees incurred by the Attorney General in bringing its Application for Injunction and Order to Compel.
- e. Violation of this Order shall be punishable as contempt of court pursuant to N.D.C.C. ch. 27-10.
