



Interstate 17: Sunset Point Rest Area

FACILITY REHABILITATION PROJECT

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation is rehabilitating the Sunset Point Rest Area facility located along Interstate 17 at milepost 252, approximately 10 miles south of Cordes Junction.

The \$7.5 million project will renovate the restrooms, vending machine building, ramadas and parking lot and will make the rest area more accessible for persons with disabilities. Construction will begin late September 2022, and the facility is expected to reopen summer 2023.

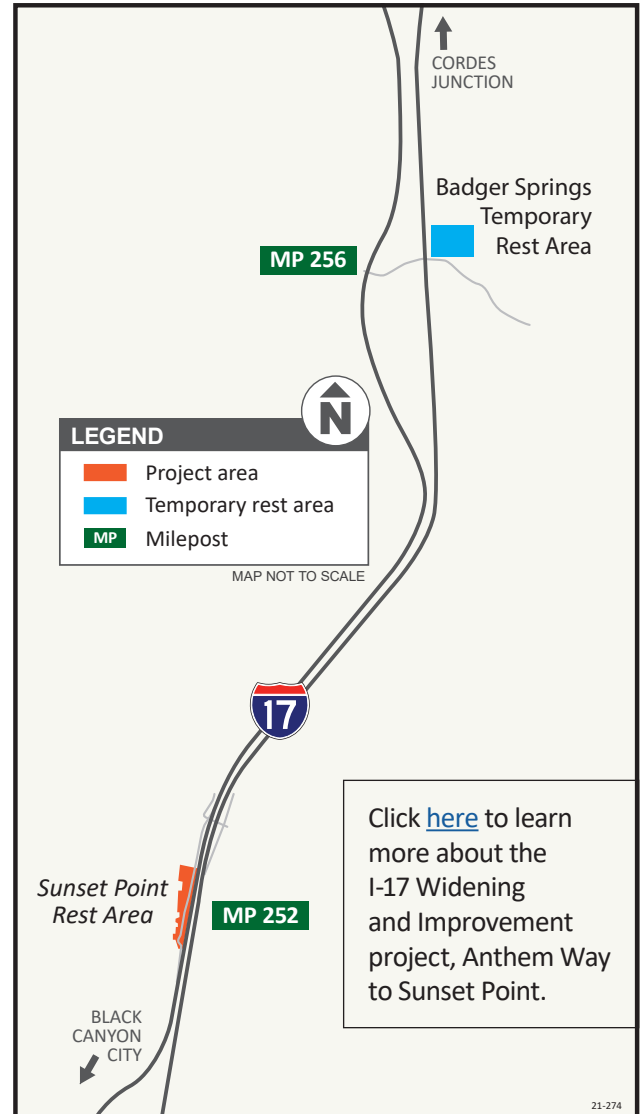
WHAT TO EXPECT

The rest area will be closed to the general public for the duration of construction.

- ▶ The existing rest area parking lot will remain open to commercial truck traffic only.
- ▶ **While the project is underway, a temporary rest area will be open four miles north of Sunset Point at the Badger Springs Road exit 256. This rest area is open to passenger vehicles and non-commercial trucks only. It will not be able to accommodate commercial vehicles, oversized loads, large RVs and vehicles with trailers. Motorists with those types of vehicles may use Sunset Point, if necessary, but are encouraged to use other nearby private facilities.**
