FISCAL IMPACT: There is no discernible fiscal impact associated with SB 2809, as amended by HA 3.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: SB 2809, as amended by HA 3, amends the General Provisions Article of the Illinois Pension Code to allow the Attorney General to bring a civil action to enjoin the payment of benefits to any person who is convicted of any felony related to that person's service as an employee under the Illinois Pension Code.

<u>FISCAL IMPACT</u>: There is no discernible fiscal impact associated with SB 2809, as amended by HA 3.

<u>COMMENT</u>: SB 2809, as amended by HA 3, would allow a civil action to be brought by the Attorney General to halt the payment of benefits to any person who is convicted of any felony relating to or arising out of that person's service as an employee, as defined by the Illinois Pension Code.
