FISCAL IMPACT: There is no discernible fiscal impact associated

with SB 2933.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: SB 2933 amends the Downstate Police Article of the Illinois Pension Code to change who is elected as the 5<sup>th</sup> member of the Board of Trustees in the event that no beneficiaries are available and willing to serve as said member.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no discernible fiscal impact associated with SB 2933.

<u>COMMENT</u>: Currently, two members of Downstate Police pension boards are appointed by the mayor or president of the Board of Trustees of the municipality associated with the pension fund. The 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> members are elected from the active participants of the Downstate Police Pension Fund by the active participants. The 5<sup>th</sup> member of the Board of Trustees of the Downstate Police Pension Fund is elected by and from the beneficiaries. SB 2933 would stipulate that if no beneficiaries are willing and able to serve as the 5<sup>th</sup> member, then the 5<sup>th</sup> member may be elected from the active participants of the Police Pension Fund by the beneficiaries.
