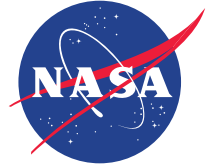


# Make NASA Climate Kids Pumpkins!

## Earth Stencil

### Directions:

1. Print this template.
2. Place the paper on the pumpkin and secure it with tape.
3. With a black permanent marker, slowly trace the outline of the shape. The marker will bleed through the paper and leave marks on the pumpkin for you to use as a guide.
4. Remove the paper.
5. Use your black marker to trace the outline of the shape.
6. Fill in the design with the black marker or black paint.



Did you know that our **Earth** isn't perfectly round? Earth is thicker around the equator--the belt around the middle of the planet. How much thicker? Well, it's about 0.3% thicker. It's not much, so when you see a photo of Earth, it appears round. But it's just barely not.
