CONSENT ORDER

It is hereby agreed between the Department of Business Regulation ("Department") and Leo Rush ("Respondent") as follows:

1. Respondent is the holder of Rhode Island nonresident insurance producer license number 1070552 issued pursuant to the terms and provisions of R.I. Gen. Laws § 27-2.4-1 *et seq.* ("License").
2. On December 28, 2007 an Order to Show cause was issued to Respondent alleging violations of R.I. Gen. Laws § 27-2.4-14. The Order to Show Cause is hereby incorporated into this Consent Order.
3. The parties appeared at a prehearing in this matter on January 29, 2008.
4. At the prehearing, Respondent informed Department counsel and the Hearing Officer that he would agree to surrender his Rhode Island nonresident insurance producer license in resolution of this matter.

Based on the foregoing, Respondent and the Department have determined to resolve this matter without instituting further administrative proceedings and hereby agree to the following resolution:

1. Respondent hereby surrenders his Rhode Island nonresident insurance producers license.
2. Respondent will cease and desist from any activities in Rhode Island for which a insurance producers license is required.
