	<u>Telecommunication</u> : Applicant must furnish a utility plan or site plan
	<ul> <li><u>Electric or Water</u>: Applicant must furnish a utility plan or site plan. Some examples are electric or irrigation meters or a utility cabinet.</li> </ul>
	Sewer Use and Drainage Permit (SUDP) purposes. Applicant must furnish a site
	plan and/or utility plan.
	• Example: certain alterations to accessory structures may result in the
	need for an address for SUD Permit purposes. Your SUDP reviewer will
