## **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Complete sections 1 and 2 of the application. If the application is not properly completed, it will be returned to you.
- 2. The registered owner must sign the application.
- 3. A combination of letters, numbers, or spaces may be used.
  - No more than two (2) numbers are allowed in combination with letters.
  - The letter "O" is considered a number "0" (zero).
  - Dots, dashes, or other special characters or symbols cannot be used.
  - A single letter is acceptable; however, the letter cannot be an "I," "J," or "O"
  - Use asterisks (\*) to indicate spaces where desired. If no asterisks (\*) are used, the characters will be centered on the plate.
- 4. A maximum of seven (7) characters may be used.

## **Exceptions:**

- a. Motor Driven Cycle, Motorcycle, and small Trailer plates are limited to a maximum of (6) characters.
- b. Disabled plates are limited to a maximum of five (5) characters.
- c. Antique and Exhibit plates are limited to a maximum of four (4) characters.
- 5. A **Special Plate Fee** of \$58.00 (per year) is due if the vehicle is currently registered in Vermont. If the vehicle is not yet registered in Vermont, complete a Registration, Tax, and Title Application (VD-119). Submit both forms and all fees for registration and this application. To see the current fees, please visit dmv.vermont.gov/registrations/fees.
- 6. Special plates are issued under the following conditions:
  - a. No prior request has been received for the same combination.
  - b. For any vehicle type except dealer, transporter, Veteran, and service & safety organizations.
  - c. A separate application must be made for plates for each vehicle.
  - d. Vanity number plates, whether new or renewed, shall be issued in any combination or succession of numerals and letters, provided the total of the numbers and letters on any plate taken together does not exceed seven, and further provided the requested combination of letters and numerals does not duplicate or resemble a regular issue registration plate.
  - e. The Commissioner may revoke any plate described in this subsection and shall not issue plates with combinations of letters or numbers that objectively, in any language:
    - are vulgar, scatological, or obscene, or constitute racial or ethnic epithets;
    - connote breast, genitalia, pubic area, or buttocks or relate to sexual or eliminatory functions;
    - refer to any intoxicant or drug; to the use, nonuse, distribution, or sale of an intoxicant or drug; or to a user, nonuser, or purveyor of an intoxicant or drug;
    - refer to gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, or disability status;
    - suggest a government or governmental agency;
    - suggest a privilege not given by law in this State or
    - form a slang term, abbreviation, phonetic spelling, or mirror image of a word described in subdivisions (1) through (6) of this subsection.
  - 7. A Vehicle not displaying a valid Vermont Inspection sticker must be inspected within 15 days of registration.
  - 8. Delivery of Special Plates may take up to 30 days from your request's approval.

NOTE: The Commissioner of Motor Vehicles can revoke plates issued in error
