If your Title Certificate has any erasures or alterations, a Title Alteration Statement (form VN-020) is required to explain why the erasures/alterations were made. If you wish to have the new title sent to an address other than what is listed on the current title, please enclose a self-addressed envelope.

This form can **NOT** be used to add or remove liens or names. Use form VT-019 to add a lien; a lien release is required to remove a lien.

## Instructions

1. Complete ALL areas that apply. If you omit any required information, the application will be returned to you.
2. If any liens were shown on the original title, please do one of the following:
  - a. For each lien on the original title, submit a lien release on the lien holder's letterhead, including the make, model, year, vessel length (Boat/Vessel), Vehicle/Vessel identification number, owner's name, and signature of the lien holder, or submit a completed Lien Release form (VT-008).
  - b. If liens are still in effect, only the lien holder may apply for a replacement and MUST sign this application.
3. **ALL owners must sign for a replacement title.** If there are more than two owners, additional applications must be completed.
4. Type of Ownership is required information if the vehicle is titled in multiple names.
  - **Tenants by the Entirety/Spouses (TEN ENT)** - Married couples (including Civil Unions), where property ownership is treated as though the couple were a single legal person. Owners have a *right of survivorship*; if one owner dies, interest in the property will pass to the surviving owner, avoiding probate.
  - **Joint Tenants (JTEN)** - Co-owners have a *right of survivorship*; if one owner dies, interest in the property will pass to the surviving owner, avoiding probate.
  - **Tenants in Common (TEN COM)** - There is no right of survivorship; if one owner dies, his or her interest in the property will become part of his or her estate.
  - **Business Partners (PTNERS)** - Owners have a right of survivorship. If one owner dies, interest in the property will pass to the surviving owner, avoiding probate.
  - **Transfer on Death (TOD)** – One owner only, form VT-007 required.
5. **Fees**
  - Vessel, ATV and Snowmobile Titles = \$27.00
  - All other Titles = \$42.00
  - Lien = \$14.00 each

## Exceptions

No Vermont certificate of title will be issued for the following:

- Motorcycles powered by electricity with less than 20 kilowatts of engine power.
- Motorcycles with an engine size smaller than 300 ccs.
- Motor-driven cycles.
- Track Vehicles (Title optional).
- Tractors with a loaded weight of 6,099 lbs. or less.
- Trailers with an empty weight of 1,500 lbs. or less.
- Vehicles or vessels regularly engaged in the interstate transportation of persons or property for which a current Certificate of Title has been issued in another state.
- Vehicles, Vessels, ATVs, or Snowmobiles owned by a manufacturer or dealer and held for sale.
- Vehicles, Vessels, ATVs, or Snowmobiles owned by the United States Government unless registered in Vermont.
- Vessels less than 16 feet in length.
- Vessels such as canoes, kayaks, or similar watercraft designed to be manually propelled or equipped with a motor not exceeding ten horsepower.
