



## Consumer's Repair Summary for A "30 Days Out of Service" Claim

- Days out-of-service must occur within the manufacturer's express warranty.
- "Out of service" is defined as the vehicle being unavailable for the consumer's use for a major portion of the day by reason of being under the control of an authorized dealer. The major portion of a day is considered four hours.
- The 30 days may be cumulative or consecutive and includes weekends and holidays.
