- 1) A civil penalty may be reduced by up to 50 percent if the person required to file has a good filing history (no late filings in the immediately preceding 5 years).² This late filed report is the Interior Republicans' first late filing in the three years they have registered as a group.
- 2) A civil penalty may be reduced by a percentage greater than 50% or waived entirely if the civil penalty assessed is significantly out of proportion to the degree of harm to the public for not having the information³. For this criteria, a penalty is considered to be significantly out of proportion to the degree of harm when it exceeds the value of the late-filed transactions. Here the penalty is \$900 and the filer's 30 day report disclosed more than \$9,000 in activity. Accordingly, staff is unable to consider this mitigator for reduction.
- 3) Based on the filer's good filing history, staff recommends the penalty be reduced by 50 percent.

We assure you of our unwavering commitment to comply with all future requisites and express our gratitude for your comprehension and collaboration.

Considering these circumstances, we respectfully request that you consider extending clemency to our group. Thank you for your recent letter notifying me of the penalty we have incurred for failing to file on time the Independent Expenditure Reports. Firstly, we want to express our gratitude for the diligence of your office in bringing this matter to our attention.

We wish to appeal for your understanding and leniency in this matter. The penalty imposed poses a significant burden on our group members and their families, and we sincerely regret any inconvenience caused to your office. It is important for us to clarify that there was never any intention to conceal our campaign activities or expenditure.

Our oversight stemmed from a lack of awareness regarding the requirement to amend our group registration following the declaration of a special election on February 17, 2024. Prior to this declaration, we had registered as a group for participation in the Fairbanks North Star Borough Elections. Upon receiving notification from your office, we promptly took corrective action by amending our group registration with your assistance and filing the necessary reports within hours of notification. We want to emphasize that our group has consistently maintained a positive track record regarding filing and has never previously breached any stipulated protocols or regulations. We have always been committed to transparency and compliance with all legal requirements.

At no time were we aware that we were doing Independent Expenditure Activities or needed to change how our group has consistently worked within our community during elections. Given that this special election was based on a Ballot Initiative it fell under different rules. Our group has always taken a position on ballot initiatives and specifically in respect to the citizens' initiative to maintain a tax cap in the Fairbanks North Star Borough which has been taking place ever 2 years for over 30 years. This Special election was no different and it was the only issue we were taking a stand on as well as providing get out the vote information pertaining to the special election. While you are stating we were influencing an election, our group will always be considered influencing an election through its Republican values.

Accordingly, I humbly implore for clemency to be extended to our group. I assure you of our unwavering commitment to comply with all future requisites and express our gratitude for your comprehension and collaboration. We are a relatively new group and were unaware that these activities did not fall under our group registration. At no time did we try to hide our activities or deceive the public in our activities in this special election. Our group have consistently maintained a positive track record in regard to filing and have never previously breached any stipulated protocols or regulations. Furthermore, we have not caused any harm to the public and have no prior history of aggravating factors.

Based on your group's 30 Day Campaign Disclosure Report, it appears that the Interior Republicans did not timely file their Independent Expenditure Reports that must be filed within 10 days after an expenditure has been made for the Fairbanks North Star Borough Special Election.

Expenditures during the period from February 21, 2024, through February 29, 2024 should have been disclosed by March 2, 2024. Instead, these expenditures were first disclosed on April 26, 2024 – 55 days late.

Expenditures during the period from March 4, 2024, through March 8, 2024, should have been disclosed by March 14, 2024. Instead, these expenditures were disclosed first disclosed on April 26, 2024 – 43 days late.

Expenditures during the period from March 19, 2024, and ending on March 29, 2024, should have been disclosed by March 29, 2024. Instead, these expenditures were first disclosed on April 26, 2024 – 28 days late.

Expenditures during the period from April 2, 2024, and ending on April 5, 2024, should have been disclosed by April 12, 2024. Instead, these expenditures were disclosed on April 26, 2024 – 14 days late.

Based on your group's 7 Day Campaign Disclosure Report, it also appears there were expenditures during the period from on April 10, 2024, and ending on April 18, 2024, that should have been disclosed by April 20, 2024, but were instead first disclosed on April 29, 2024, – 9 days late

By law a maximum penalty of \$50 accrues each day the report is late.² In total, your group is 149 days late in disclosing campaign expenditures. Accordingly, the assessed penalty owed is \$7,450.³

You may pay the assessed penalty and avoid formal Commission action by sending payment by check or money order payable to the "State of Alaska" to our office at the address above; visiting our website to make a payment by credit card; or you may pay in cash at our offices. Payment must be made within thirty days of the date of this letter. If you are unable to pay the entire assessed penalty in a single payment and wish to discuss a payment plan, or have any other question concerning this matter, please contact the APOC staff.

Alternatively, you have the right to appeal staff's conclusion that a violation has occurred, or the penalty amount assessed.⁵ If you wish to appeal you must submit the enclosed appeal affidavit to APOC within thirty days of the date of this letter.

If you appeal, staff will review your affidavit and prepare a recommendation for the Commission. You will receive a copy of that recommendation and notice of when the Commission will meet to consider the matter. You will have the opportunity to participate in the meeting either in person or telephonically.

Failure to respond to this notice by either making arrangement for payment or submitting an appeal within will result in staff presenting this matter to the Commission for a final order in the amount of the assessed penalty and referral to the Attorney General's Office.⁶

On August 29, 2024, the Alaska Public Offices Commission (Commission) reviewed the assessed civil penalty for Alaskan Conservatives for Integrity's late-filed 105 Report. The late-filed report's penalty is currently assessed at \$25.00. To facilitate collection proceedings by the Department of Law, the Commission issues the following Findings and Order.

Findings of Fact

- 1. Alaskan Conservatives for Integrity registered as a group on November 1, 2023, and became subject to AS 15.13, Campaign Disclosure Law.
- 2. Pursuant to AS 15.13.110(a)(3), Alaskan Conservatives for Integrity's 105 Day Report was due on February 20, 2024, but was not filed until February 21, 2024, one day late.
- 3. On March 21, 2024, staff issued a Notice of Penalty informing Alaskan Conservatives for Integrity of the assessed penalty for their late filed 105 Day Report. The notice included an appeal affidavit and was sent via E-Mail and Certified Mail. The email server provided delivery confirmation. The Certified Mail was delivered on April 22, 2024.
- 4. On July 30, 2024, staff issued a Notice of Referral regarding Alaskan Conservatives for Integrity's outstanding civil penalty. This notice informed Alaskan Conservatives for Integrity that their right to appeal had expired. Additionally, it requested that Alaskan Conservatives for Integrity remit payment for the assessed civil penalty or the matter would be presented to the Commission for a Final Order. The notice was sent via E-Mail and Certified Mail. The email server provided delivery confirmation. The Certified Mail is still in transit and has yet to be delivered as of August 13, 2024.

Conclusions of Law

Due to Alaskan Conservatives for Integrity's failure to timely file their 105 Day Report, and their failure to pay or appeal the assessed penalty in a timely manner, the Commission upholds a penalty assessment of \$25.00 under the provisions of AS 15.13.390 and 2 AAC 50.855.

Commission staff has exhausted efforts to collect the penalty assessed against the Alaskans for Honest Elections now due and owing to the State of Alaska under 2 AAC 50.895.

The Commission approves the referral of this case to the Office of the Attorney General to begin the formal collection process.

Decision and Order of the Commission

In accordance with the above findings of fact and conclusions of law, the Commission orders Alaskan Conservatives for Integrity to pay a civil penalty of 25.00 for failing to timely file their 105 Day Report and refers this matter for collection to the Office of the Attorney General.

Findings of Fact

- 1. Alaskans for Honest Elections registered as an Initiative Proposal Application Group on March 20, 2023, and is subject to AS 15.13, Campaign Disclosure Law.
- 2. Pursuant to AS 15.13.110(g), Alaskans for Honest Elections' First Quarter Report was due on April 10, 2024.
- 3. On April 11, 2024, staff issued a Notice of Deficiency to Alaskans for Honest Elections informing the group, that as of the date of the notice, their First Quarter report was one day late. The notice also informed the group that a daily penalty would continue to accrue until the report was filed and that the group had a right to appeal the assessment of a penalty. The notice was sent via E-mail and Certified Mail. The email server provided delivery confirmation. The Certified Mail was refused on April 13, 2024.¹
- 4. On April 11, 2024, Alaskans for Honest Elections filed their First Quarter Report, five days late.


