Policy

Probation officers will cooperate with law enforcement agencies investigating violations by offenders, and other service agencies providing services to offenders, victims and potential victims.

Procedures

A. Cooperation with law enforcement agencies.

1. The probation officer shall provide any information, which will aid in a police investigation, other than information confidential by law, to law enforcement agencies.
2. Probation officers shall maintain effective communication with local law enforcement agencies for the exchange of information relative to offenders. Probation officers may not act as an agent for the police but may act independently on police provided information and seek police assistance during investigations.

B. Cooperation with service agencies.

1. Probation officers shall maintain regular contact with agencies providing services to offenders, their families, victims and potential victims to ensure coordinated approaches to community protection and offender rehabilitation.
