SUBJECT: COUNCIL OF REPRESENTATIVES

THE NEXT MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF REPRESENTATIVES WILL BE HELD ON TUESDAY, 29 MAY 1973, IN THE PALAIS DES NATIONS AT GENEVA. THE MEETING WILL BEGIN AT 9.30 A.M. THE WORKING PARTIES ON THE FREE-TRADE AGREEMENTS WITH THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES WILL PROCEED WITH THEIR WORK THE SAME MORNING IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE ADJOURNMENT OF THE COUNCIL.
