I HAVE RECEIVED A REMORANDUM FROM ONE OF THE CONTRACTING PARTIES
SUGGESTING THAT IT WOULD BE HELPFUL FOR CONTRACTING PARTIES TO KNOW WHAT
OTHER GOVERNMENTS ARE THINKING ABOUT THE IMPORTANT ISSUES WHICH WERE
DISCUSSED AT THE HEADS OF DELEGATIONS MEETINGS HELD DURING THE ELEVENTH
SESSION AND NOTABLY IN RESPECT OF THE SUGGESTION THAT MINISTERS SHOULD BE
PRESENT AT SOME TIME DURING THE TWELFTH SESSION. IT WAS FURTHER
SUGGESTED THAT IT WOULD BE HELPFUL IF INFORMATION ON THESE MATTERS
COULD BE MADE AVAILABLE EITHER BEFORE OR AT THE JUNE MEETING OF THE
INTERSESSIONAL COMMITTEE SO THAT CONTRACTING PARTIES COULD MAKE THEIR
PLANS WELL IN ADVANCE FOR THE NEXT SESSION.

IT SEEMS TO ME THAT THESE SUGGESTIONS HAVE CONSIDERABLE MERIT AND

I WOULD THEREFORE HOPE THAT CONTRACTING PARTIES WOULD BE IN A POSITION

EITHER TO INDICATE THEIR VIEWS IN WRITING FOR DISTRIBUTION TO THE

CONTRACTING PARTIES PRIOR TO THE JUNE MEETING, OR TO STATE THEIR VIEWS

DURING THE COURSE OF THE JUNE MEETING.
