SUBJECT: TRADE NEGOTIATIONS COMMITTEE

1. THE TRADE NEGOTIATIONS COMMITTEE WILL RESUME ITS WORK AT 10 A.M. ON WEDNESDAY 17 JULY 1974. THE MEETING WILL BE HELD IN THE GOVERNING BODY ROOM OF THE INTERNATIONAL LABOUR OFFICE.
2. THE COMMITTEE WILL HAVE BEFORE IT REPORTS FROM THE GROUPS WHICH IT SET UP AT ITS FEBRUARY MEETING TO UNDERTAKE THE TASKS IN ITS PROGRAMME OF WORK (MTN/2 AND MTN/P/2).
3. THE MAIN TASKS BEFORE THE COMMITTEE WILL BE
 - (a) TO CONSIDER THE REPORTS FROM THE GROUPS AND
 - (b) TO CONSIDER HOW BEST TO CARRY ITS WORK FORWARD.
4. IT WILL BE RECALLED THAT MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMITTEE IS OPEN TO THOSE COUNTRIES WHICH DECIDE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MULTILATERAL TRADE NEGOTIATIONS. MEMBERS ARE INVITED TO INFORM ME AS SOON AS POSSIBLE OF THE NAMES OF THEIR REPRESENTATIVES WHO WILL ATTEND THE MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE.
5. REPRESENTATIVES NOT HAVING YET REGISTERED FOR THE MULTILATERAL TRADE NEGOTIATIONS ARE REQUESTED TO REGISTER WITH THE CONFERENCE OFFICER, VILLA LE BOGAGE, AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, TO OBTAIN THE NECESSARY ENTRANCE CARDS.
