SUBJECT: GROUP 3(c)

1. AS AGREED BY THE TRADE NEGOTIATIONS COMMITTEE ON 17-18 JULY 1974, A MEETING OF THE GROUP, ESTABLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAYOUT OF PARAGRAPH 3(c) OF THE TOKYO DECLARATION, WILL BE CONVENED TO EXAMINE THE METHODOLOGY FOR THE SECTOR APPROACH. THE MEETING WILL BEGIN AT 3 P.M. ON MONDAY, 7 OCTOBER 1974, AND WILL BE HELD IN THE PALAIS DES NATIONS.
2. RELEVANT DOCUMENTS FOR THE WORK OF THE GROUP ARE:
  - (a) THE SECTOR APPROACH AS A TECHNIQUE FOR MULTILATERAL TRADE LIBERALIZATION; NOTE SUBMITTED BY CANADA (DOCUMENT COM.IND/W/109);
  - (b) REPORT ON STATUS OF WORK BY THE COMMITTEE ON TRADE IN INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS (DOCUMENT L/3886, PARAGRAPHS 63-69).
3. THE MEETING IS OPEN TO THOSE COUNTRIES WHICH HAVE INDICATED THEIR DECISION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE MULTILATERAL TRADE NEGOTIATIONS AND HAVE THUS ASSUMED MEMBERSHIP OF THE TRADE NEGOTIATIONS COMMITTEE. SUCH MEMBERS ARE ACCORDINGLY INVITED TO INFORM ME AS SOON AS POSSIBLE OF THE NAMES OF THEIR REPRESENTATIVES WHO WILL ATTEND THE MEETING OF THE GROUP.
4. REPRESENTATIVES NOT HAVING YET REGISTERED FOR THE MULTILATERAL TRADE NEGOTIATIONS ARE REQUESTED TO REGISTER WITH THE CONFERENCE OFFICER, VILLA LE BOGAGE, AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, TO OBTAIN THE NECESSARY ENTRANCE CARDS.
