SUBJECT: OFFICE SPACE FOR CONSULTATIONS IN JUNE 1957

1. IT HAS NOT BEEN POSSIBLE TO SECURE OFFICE SPACE FOR DELEGATIONS IN THE PALAIS DES NATIONS FOR THE ARTICLE XII CONSULTATIONS FROM 11 TO 29 JUNE 1957. HOWEVER, THE AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF GENEVA HAVE OFFERED TO PLACE AT THE DISPOSAL OF DELEGATIONS TWENTY FURNISHED OFFICES IN THE BATIMENT ELECTORAL LOCATED NEAR THE UNIVERSITY OF GENEVA (PLACE NEUVE). EACH OFFICE WILL BE LARGE ENOUGH TO ACCOMMODATE TWO OR THREE PERSONS.
2. IN ORDER TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THIS OFFER AND TO MAKE SUITABLE ARRANGEMENTS, IT IS ESSENTIAL TO HAVE ADVANCE INFORMATION AS TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF DELEGATIONS.
3. THE PRICE WILL BE SW.FR. 7 PER DAY IF ALL TWENTY OFFICES ARE RENTED, BUT WILL BE PROPORTIONATELY HIGHER IF FEWER THAN TWENTY ARE TAKEN. (A FEW GOVERNMENTS HAVE ENQUIRED WHETHER OFFICES CAN BE OBTAINED.) THESE TWENTY OFFICES HAVE BEEN TENTATIVELY RESERVED BUT CONFIRMATION MUST BE GIVEN BEFORE THE END OF MAY. THEREFORE, CONTRACTING PARTIES WHICH WISH TO OBTAIN OFFICE SPACE FOR THEIR DELEGATIONS ARE ASKED TO INFORM ME NOT LATER THAN 28 MAY OF THE NUMBER OF OFFICES THEY WILL REQUIRE.
