SUBJECT: TRADE NEGOTIATIONS COMMITTEE

1. FOLLOWING CONSULTATIONS WITH DELEGATIONS, THE TRADE NEGOTIATIONS COMMITTEE WILL RESUME ITS WORK AT 10 A.M. ON TUESDAY 11 FEBRUARY 1975. THE MEETING WILL BE HELD IN ROOM XVI IN THE PALAIS DES NATIONS.
2. THE MAIN TASKS BEFORE THE COMMITTEE WILL BE:
 - (a) TO TAKE NOTE OF THE INITIAL POSITIONS OF GOVERNMENTS ON THE MULTILATERAL TRADE NEGOTIATIONS AND, IN THE LIGHT OF THESE,
 - (b) TO AGREE ON A LIST OF ISSUES TO BE TAKEN UP IN THE INITIAL STAGES OF THE NEGOTIATIONS, AND
 - (c) TO AGREE ON THE PROCEDURES FOR NEGOTIATING ON THESE ISSUES.
3. IT WILL BE RECALLED THAT MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMITTEE IS OPEN TO COUNTRIES PARTICIPATING IN THE MULTILATERAL TRADE NEGOTIATIONS. MEMBERS ARE INVITED TO INFORM ME AS SOON AS POSSIBLE OF THE NAMES OF THEIR REPRESENTATIVES WHO WILL ATTEND THE MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE.
4. REPRESENTATIVES NOT HAVING YET REGISTERED FOR THE MULTILATERAL TRADE NEGOTIATIONS ARE REQUESTED TO REGISTER WITH THE CONFERENCE OFFICER, VILLA LE BOULGE, AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, TO OBTAIN THE NECESSARY ENTRANCE CARDS.
