SUBJECT: WORKING PARTY ON PAPUA NEW GUINEA/AUSTRALIA TRADE AND
COMMERCIAL RELATIONS AGREEMENT

1. THE WORKING PARTY ESTABLISHED BY THE COUNCIL AT ITS MEETING ON 2 MARCH 1977, "TO EXAMINE, IN THE LIGHT OF THE RELEVANT PROVISIONS OF THE GENERAL AGREEMENT, THE PROVISIONS OF THE AGREEMENT ON TRADE AND COMMERCIAL RELATIONS BETWEEN AUSTRALIA AND PAPUA NEW GUINEA, AND TO REPORT TO THE COUNCIL" WILL MEET ON 6 AND 7 OCTOBER 1977. THE MEETING WILL TAKE PLACE IN THE CENTRE WILLIAM RAPPARD, 154 RUE DE LAUSANNE, GENEVA AND WILL COMMENCE AT 10.30 A.M. ON 6 OCTOBER.
