SUBJECT: FIRST AGREEMENT ON TRADE NEGOTIATIONS AMONG DEVELOPING MEMBER COUNTRIES OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COMMISSION FOR ASIA AND THE PACIFIC - BANGKOK AGREEMENT

1. THE WORKING PARTY ESTABLISHED BY THE GATT COUNCIL AT ITS MEETING ON 12 NOVEMBER 1976, "TO EXAMINE, IN THE LIGHT OF THE RELEVANT PROVISIONS OF THE GENERAL AGREEMENT, THE PROVISIONS OF THE BANGKOK AGREEMENT, AND TO REPORT TO THE COUNCIL" WILL MEET ON MONDAY, 21 NOVEMBER 1977, AT 10 A.M. IN THE CENTRE WILLIAM RAPPARD, 154 RUE DE LAUSANNE, GENEVA. THE WORKING PARTY WILL RECONVENE AT AN APPROPRIATE DATE LATER IN THE WEEK 21-25 NOVEMBER TO ADOPT ITS REPORT.
