SUBJECT: GROUP OF EXPERTS ON ANTI-DUMPING AND COUNTERVAILING DUTIES

AT THEIR FOURTEENTH SESSION THE CONTRACTING PARTIES IN APPROVING THE FIRST REPORT OF THE GROUP OF EXPERTS ON ANTI-DUMPING AND COUNTERVAILING DUTIES DECIDED THAT A SECOND MEETING OF THE GROUP SHOULD BE CONVENED IN 1960 (SR.14/2 AND SR.14/11). THIS DECISION WAS CONFIRMED AT THE FIFTEENTH SESSION BY THE ADOPTION OF THE PROGRAMME OF MEETINGS FOR 1960. THIS MEETING WILL TAKE PLACE IN THE PALAIS DES NATIONS, GENEVA, FROM 18-22 JANUARY COMMENCING AT 3 P.M. ON MONDAY 18 JANUARY.

THE QUESTIONS WHICH THE GROUP WILL HAVE TO CONSIDER ARE ENUMERATED IN PARAGRAPH 24 OF ITS FIRST REPORT (L/978). IN THE DISCUSSION OF THIS REPORT AT THE FOURTEENTH SESSION A FEW ADDITIONAL PROBLEMS TO BE DISCUSSED BY THE EXPERTS HAVE BEEN RAISED (SR.14/2).
