SUBJECT: PARTECIPATION OF THE MEMCUTIVE SECRETARY IN THE COMMITTEE . PPOINTED BY THE MEMBERS AND ASSOCIATE METABLES OF THE OFFIC TO CONSIDER CERTAIN TRADE PROBLEMS

I HAVE BEEN ADVISED THAT AT A MEETING OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE COUNTRIES MEMBERS AND ASSOCIATE MEMBERS OF THE ORGANISATION FOR EUROPEAN ECONOMIC COOPERATION. TOGETHER WITH A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE EUROPEAN ECONOMIC COMMUNITY, IN PARIS ON 14 JANUARY, A RESOLUTION WAS APPROVED CONSTITUTING A COMMITTED TO CONSIDER CERTAIN TRADE PROBLEMS. THE TEAT OF THIS RESOLUTION IS AS FOLLOWS:-

"RESOLUTION ON TRADE PROBLEMS

THE SPECIAL ECONOMIC COMMITTEE

RECOGNITING THAT THERE ARE PROBLEMS OF COMMERCIAL POLICY OF PRIICULER CONGERN TO THE TWENTY GOVERNMENTS WHO TRE MEMBERS OF, OR ISSOCI TE WITH, THE OREC;

TAKING NOTE OF THE MIISTANCE OF THE EEC AND OF THE CONVENTION FOR AN EFTA:

BEARING IN MIND THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE FROVISIONS OF TALS AGREEMENTS AND GENERAL INTERNATIONAL COMMERCIAL POLICY:

CONSIDERING THE NEED TO ELIMINE. . S A MATTER OF PRIORITY, THE RELECTIONSHIP BETWEEN THE EEC AND THE EFT. WITH DUE REGERO TO THE COMMERCIAL INTERESTS OF THIRD COUNTRIES AND THE PRINCIPLES AND OBLIGHTIONS OF THE GATT.

DECIDES TO PROPOSE TO THE TWENTY GOVERNMENTS THAT THEY CONSTITUTE THEMSELVES, TOGETHER WITH THE EEC, A COMMITTEE WITH POWER TO

- EST. BLISH ONE OR MORE INFORMAL WORKING GROUPS, FOR THE CONSIDER TION OF THESE PROBLEMS WITHOUT INFRINGING THE COMPETENCE OF THE MAISTING INTERNATIONAL INSTITUTIONS SUCH AS THE GATT OR THE OBMC; THESE CROUPS SHOULD REPORT B. CK TO THE COMMITTEE;
- TRANSMIT AN INVITATION TO THE EMECUTIVE SECRETARY OF THE GATT TO PARTICIPATE IN THESE DISCUSSIONS."

SENT BY: Executive Secretary, GATT, Tel. address: ICITO GENEVA CONTRACTING PARTIES WILL NOTE THAT THE GOVERNMENTS
CONCERNED HAVE ETPRESSLY INDICATED THAT THE PROPOSED
DISCUSSIONS SHOULD NOT "INFRINGE THE COMPETENCE OF THE
EXISTING INTERNATIONAL INSTITUTIONS SUCH AS THE GATT"
AND MOREOVER THAT THE EXAMINATION OF "THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN
THE EEC AND THE EFTA." IS TO BE CARRIED OUT "WITH DUE REGARD TO
THE COMMERCIAL INTERESTS OF THIRD COUNTRIES AND THE PRINCIPLES
AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE GATT". I UNDERSTAND THAT IT IS THESE
CONSIDERATIONS WHICH HAVE LED THE GOVERNMENTS CONCERNED TO
EXTRESS THE WISH THAT I SHOULD PARTICIPATE IN THE MEETINGS OF
THE COMMITTEE. IN THESE CIRCUMSTANCES AND HAVING REGARD TO THE
CLOSE CONNECTED OF THE QUESTIONS WITH WHICH THE COMMITTEE WILL
BE DEALING WITH THE GENERAL AGREEMENT, I HAVE DECIDED TO ACCEPT
THE INVITATION.
