SUBJECT: EIGHTEENTH SESSION OF THE CONTRACTING PARTIES -  
OFFICE SPACE FOR DELEGATIONS

THE POSITION REGARDING THE ABOVE SUBJECT IS VIRTUALLY THE SAME AS THAT OUTLINED IN GATT/AIR/197, EXCEPT THAT VERY LIMITED OFFICE SPACE WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR DELEGATIONS IN THE PALAIS DES NATIONS.

CONTRACTING PARTIES ARE THEREFORE AGAIN URGED TO:

- (a) REDUCE THEIR REQUESTS FOR OFFICE SPACE FOR THE EIGHTEENTH SESSION TO A MINIMUM;
- (b) DOUBLE UP WITH THEIR DELEGATIONS TO THE TARIFF CONFERENCE WHEREVER POSSIBLE;
- (c) EXPLORE THE POSSIBILITY OF ACCOMMODATING THEIR DELEGATIONS TO THE EIGHTEENTH SESSION IN THEIR PERMANENT DELEGATION OFFICES IN GENEVA.

THEREAFTER, CONTRACTING PARTIES ARE REQUESTED TO NOTIFY THE SECRETARIAT, NOT LATER THAN 15 MARCH, OF ANY RESIDUAL REQUIREMENTS THEY MAY HAVE IN REGARD TO OFFICE SPACE.
