SUBJECT: SCHEDULE XIX - UNITED KINGDOM  
RE-NEGOTIATION OF AN ITEM UNDER ARTICLE XXVIII

THE UNITED KINGDOM WISHES TO NOTIFY CONTRACTING PARTIES OF ITS INTENTION TO RE-NEGOTIATE A BINDING ON PRESERVED STRAWBERRIES AND STRAWBERRY PULP ORIGINALLY NEGOTIATED WITH FRANCE AND THE NETHERLANDS.

HAVING REGARD TO THE FACT THAT THE MEMBER STATES OF THE EUROPEAN ECONOMIC COMMUNITY HAVE INVOKED (IN L/1406 OF 9 JANUARY 1961) ARTICLE XXVIII:5 THE UNITED KINGDOM WILL PROCEED TO NEGOTIATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROCEDURE OF PARAGRAPHS 1-3 OF ARTICLE XXVIII.

A STATEMENT OF STATISTICS OF THE IMPORTS OF THESE PRODUCTS INTO THE UNITED KINGDOM OVER THE LAST THREE YEARS IS ATTACHED.

ANY CONTRACTING PARTY CONSIDERING IT HAS AN INTEREST SHOULD NOTIFY THE UNITED KINGDOM DELEGATION WITHOUT DELAY.
